## **Outdoor Opportunities** By COL (Ret.) Grey D. Berrier II

Let's Look at Some Significant Changes for the 2020-21 Hunting Year (Part 3 of 3)

Since we've been focusing on significant changes for the past few weeks, let me ask you something.

What do you think is the biggest change PA hunters have undergone in the past 50-years? Now, there is no right or wrong answer, but if that was an essay question on an exam and I had to provide a response along with supporting information to defend my conclusion, I know how I would respond. Because it is so common today, many hunters under the age of 50 would not know his, but the biggest change in my opinion is the proliferation of archery hunting. Whether you realize it or not, fifty years ago, back in 1970, there were far fewer than 25,000 bowhunters across the entire Commonwealth when your equipment choices were primarily limited to long bows and recurve bows. The 1980's saw compound bows become widely available and the number of PA bowhunters rapidly increased. Today, well over 250,000 PA hunters purchase an archery license each year. A remarkable ten-fold increase over the past 50-years.


Now, you may be thinking, if there were fewer than 25,000 bowhunters 50-years ago and close to one million hunting licenses were sold each year back then, what were all those folks hunting in October and November before the firearms deer season opened on the Monday after Thanksgiving? The answer would be small game. There was a time when the pursuit of rabbits, squirrels, pheasants, and grouse was the passionate pursuit of the masses before a significant portion of hunters became overwhelmingly interested in compound bows and tree stands to relentlessly pursue deer. Unfortunately, along the way, many young hunters lost interest in hunting because their parents and grandparents were so busy archery deer hunting, they didn't make time to take their young hunters out for small game. While adults think nothing of sitting motionless for hours and patiently wait days for a single shot at a deer; young hunters would rather take a shot at something on an hourly basis and when they can't, often label hunting "boring" in their minds, and then seek other activities to fill their time. Unfortunately, many give up hunting permanently.

To help encourage small game hunting, the PA Game Commission has implemented a few significant changes for the 2020-21 hunting year. First, our statewide squirrel season now opens on September 12, a full three weeks before the statewide archery deer opener on October 3. Parents, grandparents, and

other mentors will have time to take their youth hunters afield in pursuit of squirrels when the weather's comfortable and hunting seasons for other species aren't open. Second, hunters will now be able to legally harvest either-sex pheasants statewide, except in the four designated Wild Pheasant Recovery Areas. (All four WPRAs are over 100 miles from Lawrence County with the closest one down in Somerset County.)

In other significant hunting changes. Fall turkey season will be open for various lengths in 21 of 23 WMUs across the state. (Please check your 2020-21 PA Hunting & Trapping Digest for details.) Of special interest, Fall turkey will be open Wed. - Fri., Nov. 25-27, sandwiched around Thanksgiving in 12 WMUs. Unfortunately, that excludes our area, WMU 1A. Additionally, the extended elk season held outside the elk management area has been eliminated. These additional days were provided to elk hunters, who were drawn for a tag and failed to fill it during the general season. However, over the years of its existence, no one ever harvested an extended season elk, so it was formally abolished. Just a reminder, applications for the three upcoming PA elk seasons (archery, general, and late), which are awarded by lottery, are due today, July 31, 2020. While of interest to waterfowl hunters, the bag limit on scaup, an easily identifiable blue-billed diving duck, has changed and now varies from one (early) to two (late) during different parts of the upcoming waterfowl seasons. (Please check your Digest for details.)

Trappers in our area should be very pleased with some of the changes implemented for the 2020-21 trapping season. For the first time, river otter trapping season has been expanded to include WMUs 1A, 1B, and 2F. (Limit 1 per license year with permit.) Yes, there are otters in the Shenango River drainage. Also, the season limit on beavers has been increased from 40 to 60 in WMUs 1A and 1B, since they are a very prolific species and only a limited number of dedicated trappers are pursuing them. Additionally, bobcat hunting and trapping will be permitted for the first time, Dec. 19 - Jan. 10 in WMU 2B, permit required, limit one. Hard to believe, but bobcats can be found in Allegheny County and those suburban portions of surrounding counties. Also, don't forget the 1st round of unsold antlerless licenses become available on Mon., Aug. 3. It just keeps getting better! God Bless, Be Safe, and Great Outdoors! ©WBB 2020

## A Taste of Summer **Recipe Corner**

#### Sweet Corn Cake By Lee Ann Clarke

1/2 cup Butter, with salt 1/3 cup Corn flour, masa, enriched

1/4 cup Water

18

- $1 \frac{1}{2}$  cups sweet corn, kernels cut off cob
- 1/4 cup Yellow Cornmeal, whole-grain
- 1/3 cup Sugars, granulated
- 2 Tbsp. heavy whipping cream
- 1/4 tsp. Salt, table
- 1/2 tsp. double acting baking powder

• In a medium bowl beat butter until it is creamy. Add corn flour and water and beat until well mixed. Using a food processor, process corn, but leave chunky. Stir into the butter mixture. In a separate bowl, mix cornmeal, sugar, cream, salt, and baking powder. Add to corn flour mixture and stir to combine. Pour batter into an ungreased 8"x8" baking pan. Smooth batter and cover with aluminum foil. Place pan into a 9"x13" baking dish that is filled a third of the way with water. Bake in preheated 350° oven for 50 to 60 minutes. Allow to cool for 10 minutes. Use an ice cream scoop for easy removal from pan.

## **Blueberry Zucchini Bread**

by: Laura Moody

- 3 eggs, lightly beaten
- 1 cup vegetable oil 3 teaspoons vanilla extract
- 21/4 cups white sugar
- 2 cups shredded zucchini
- 3 cups all-purpose flour
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1 teaspoon baking powder
- 1/4 teaspoon baking soda
- 1 tablespoon ground cinnamon
- 1 pint fresh blueberries

• Preheat oven to 350°. Lightly grease 4 mini-loaf pans. In a large bowl, beat together eggs, oil, vanilla, and sugar. Fold in zucchini. Beat in flour, salt, baking powder, baking soda, and cinnamon. Gently fold in blueberries. Transfer to prepared mini-loaf pans. Bake 50 minutes in preheated oven, or until a knife inserted in the center of a loaf comes out clean. Cool 20 minutes in pans, then turn out onto wire racks to cool completely.


