Optional: Refried Beans, Sour Cream





Outdoor Opportunities By COL (Ret.) Grey D. Berrier II

This Hunting Season, I've Got to Give Credit Where Credit is Due (Part 1 of 2)

If you're an avid or even casual hockey fan, you know when it comes to a player's scoring statistics, his/ her points is a compilation of the goals they've personally scored and the assists he/she has rendered on their teammate's goals. Being a team sport, these assists or "helpers" are vitally important in hockey and are closely tracked, since they often measure a player's valuable ability to "see the ice", along with their passing prowess and unselfishness. Now, when it comes to hunting, you don't often hear it talked about, but there are assists or "helpers" frequently involved in a successful harvest when it comes to a wide variety of species. An assist should go to the landowner who gave you permission to hunt on their property, the "drivers" who pushed a bear your way as they made their way through the thick mountain laurel, the friend who recommended you set up your tree stand in a particular spot because that's where the deer always cross, or the stranger who helped you drag your deer out of the woods. There are often assists when it comes to a successful hunt and I feel it's important to share those details whenever you tell your story because without their assistance, in whatever form, you probably would not have gotten that buck, bear, or whichever species you successfully harvested that particular day. It reminds me of the line from the popular 1983 country hit, "Thank God For You", by the band Sawyer Brown that says it succinctly, "I got to give credit where credit is due".

Over the past two weeks, Nov. 6 & 13, I shared details of past pheasant hunts which vividly came to mind after I successfully harvested two ringneck roosters on Oct. 28 and two more on Oct. 30. Well, I have to give the assist to my wife because if it wasn't for her recommendation, I wouldn't have gotten those birds. You see, when we were first married, we had a golden retriever named Nugget, who came from a hardto-find hunting bloodline; and I hunted pheasants, grouse, and woodcock with her as often as possible. However, since she passed away in Dec. 1997. I just haven't had the zeal to pursue upland birds the way I once did. I eventually would like to get another bird bog at some point, but not having one kept me from purchasing a PA adult pheasant permit in the first two-years they were required, 2018 and 2019.

Back on Wed., Oct. 28, my wife texted me and asked if I could drop something off for her at work that she had forgot. I gladly did it and when I briefly spoke to her when I handed off the item she requested, I mentioned on the way down I saw a truck with crates on the back towing a trailer hauling an ATV and it was probably the PA Game Commission out stocking pheasants. My wife replied, "We haven't had any pheasant for dinner in years. You ought to hunt them again sometime."

That was enough to plant the seed and afterwards I stopped at Walmart to purchase my first mandatory pheasant permit. Living adjacent to PA State Game Lands 150, I decided to try my luck that afternoon and because this was going to be quite the trip down memory lane, I elected to take my venerable first firearm, a Mossberg 500 20-gauge pump shotgun dad bought me when I was 11. That afternoon, I was rewarded for my efforts with two beautiful roosters and then I harvested two more on Fri., Oct. 30, before 8:15 AM. Looking back, I probably wouldn't have even purchased a 2020 pheasant permit and gone out after those birds, if my wife hadn't said something. Mary definitely gets the assists on pheasants this year and I'm very thankful for her gentle encouragement to get back out after the birds after all these years. I was blessed to harvest a nice 8-point

whitetail on our property in Pulaski Township during archery season in 2017. However, in 2018 and 2019, I had both the blessing and curse of seeing and relentlessly pursuing a Venango County 14-point that was by far the biggest PA buck I had seen in 20-years. The fact his antlers would score well above 150-inches and the knowledge the bottom of his belly was about the same height as the backs of the does he towered over kept me getting up at 3:30 AM, driving 50-minutes, and then walking back in for 1.5-miles in the darkness day-after-day; all while fighting the temptation to down other bucks that met PA antler restrictions, but just weren't him. Once again . my wife has to get the assist because she convinced me to give up my obsession of pursuing only that one Venango county buck in 2020 and in the era of COVID-19 restrictions and staying close to home, to spend my archery season hunting our property behind the house. Next week, I'll share the story of my 2020 archery buck and on this harvest, Mary didn't get the only "helper".
