

Tears on My Keyboard: I've Lost My Shadow Who Always Had My Back (Part 2 of 4)

variety of subjects, but I've learned to do an online search on the subject before sharing the idea(s) with anyone because my initial thoughts may or may not be valid. The harsh reality of losing our faithful four-legged family member Colby in late April got me thinking there has to be extensive research on the physical, psychological, and emotional benefits of having, caring for, going through life with, and loving a dog. Just labelling it "being a pet owner" seems too simplistic to me and doesn't capture all the responsibilities and rewards of bringing a dog into your life in such a close bond. Sure enough, I came across dozens of medical studies and scientific journal research papers documenting mutualism in the human being/canine connection, which is defined as a symbiotic relationship in which both species benefit. One article I came across, "Ten Surprising Benefits of Having a Dog You Didn't Know About" by Psychotherapist Amy Morin, succinctly summarized the scientific findings that dogs offer more than just companionship and there are quite a few good reasons to thank the dog(s) in your life. Not offered in any sort of prioritized order, these 10 benefits are: (1) You'll exercise more, (2) You'll feel less stressed, (3) Your social life may improve (strangers are more apt to talk to you, if you have a dog with you), (4) You may detect cancer sooner (a dog's amazing sense of smell at work here), (5) Your kids will be less likely to have allergies, (6) Your heart will be healthier, (7) You're less likely to feel depressed, (8) You can grow old gracefully, (9) Your risk for general illness decreases, and (10) You'll feel safer. There's clearly a lot going on when you make a special canine part of your family.

As an avid outdoorsman, I truly believe a dog is a living and breathing "outdoor opportunity", which you also get to take indoors and spend as much quality time with as you choose to. Having a dog means you need to take it outside several times a day, regardless of the weather, temperature, and light conditions. With our German Shepherd: Colby, taking him outside was always an adventure from the time he was a puppy. Based on his breed and their innate protective/herding instincts, one of his first behaviors whenever he went outdoors was to carefully examine his surroundings (the sights, sounds, and smells) and then since our yard comprises several acres, he would (as we labelled it from my military experi-

I regularly have hunches on a wide ence) "check the perimeter" by walking an extensive loop around our house and pole barn, whether it was morning, afternoon, or night. Living in a rural area, this regularly resulted in encounters with a wide variety of wildlife (which I'll elaborate more on next week). From the time he was six-months until he was ten, we would walk our familiar one-mile loop around Pulaski just about every day, and sometimes more than once, in both daylight and darkness. I'm sure many neighbors and several drivers regularly passing through on PA-208 would think "there goes that guy with his German Shepherd again".

We learned early on in our relationship with Colby that having a German Shepherd in the family is like having a strongwilled child. Fortunately, we had a lot of experience with that, since my wife and I, along with our three children, are all strong-willed in our own special and unique ways, so he fit in guite nicely in what quickly became "his pack". Having three Golden Retrievers previously in our family, we soon learned with Colby a German Shepherd can be just as much of a big baby with family members as our Golden Retrievers ever were, possibly even more; but with the rest of the world, he was all business and perpetually on guard. We found it amusing how he would constantly move around our house, so he could watch over as many family members as possible at any one time. Additionally, he would seem depressed after one of our adult children visited and then had to return to their homes, as if he was somehow responsible for losing a member of the herd he was supposed to always shepherd over. Whenever I worked outside, I knew he was always watching my back, to the extent my wife would refer to him as my shadow and I couldn't go anywhere without my shadow following me. Over the years, I received dozens of photos from my wife and children of Colby moping at home because I had just left him to go to work, deer hunting, or do other things where you can't take your dog and they don't understand why that is. Our vehicles were always his vehicles and I simply had the privilege of being his perpetual chauffeur. Looking back and doing some simple math, it's a fact that over almost 11.5 years. Colby and I walked over 5,000 miles together and traveled over 50,000 miles together in our vehicles. Here's hoping your past or present canine connection was or is also that strong and extensive!  $1 \frac{1}{8}$ cups white sugar 1 teaspoon distilled white vinegar

1 teaspoon vanilla extract 1 tablespoon cornstarch Whipped Cream

Fresh Fruit, washed and prepared • Preheat oven to 350°. Beat egg whites and sugar

in a large, clean bowl with electric mixer until stiff peaks form. In separate bowl, mix together vinegar, vanilla and cornstarch until smooth. Pour cornstarch mixture into egg white mixture and beat until thick and glossy, 4 minutes. Cover a baking sheet in parchment paper and draw an 8 inch (20 centimeter) circle in the center. Spoon or pipe mixture inside the circle, to within a little less than an inch (2 centimeters) from the edge. Place in preheated oven, reduce temperature to 200°, and bake 1 hour. Turn oven off and leave Pavlova to cool inside. Decorate cooled Pavlova with whipped cream and fruit to serve.
