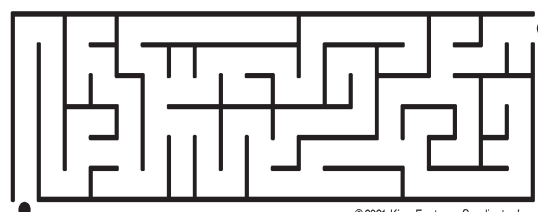
Strange But True

Dealing with a Potentially Very Smelly Situation (Part 2 of 2)

Garth Brooks stated it very accurately in one of his hit songs back in 1992. The second verse of that recording, which you might recognize, begins: "Well it was bound to happen and one night it did." Surprisingly, that's the thought that came to my mind when I turned the corner at 7 AM on Mon., Aug. 16, 2021 and saw a large skunk in one of the live traps defending my sweet corn. Even though I was using strawberry preserves and marshmallows for bait and had only caught raccoons in my live traps with that combination for years, I always had it in the back of my mind, eventually I was going to catch a skunk.

Now, there are a few things you need to know about skunks. They are omnivores and prolific insect-eaters, often digging up grubs and underground yellow jacket colonies, along with preying on mice. Skunks are fascinating creatures with a God-given, very potent defense mechanism. The source of their terrible phew is two anal glands, which produce a sulphur-based organic compound called a thiol (think rotten-egg odor) and can be smelled from up to 1/2-mile away. Skunks are discriminating when it comes to discharging their noxious defense, since a full spray that "empties the tank" could take close to 10-days to completely recharge and leave the skunk defenseless during an extended time frame. Most wild predators know to give skunks, with their unique black and white stripes (though some may be entirely black or completely white), wide berth and leave them alone. Dogs seem to have lost this knowledge and periodically tangle with skunks and suffer the foul-smelling consequences. Remarkably, skunks are rather nearsighted and seem to be almost oblivious of anything 10-feet or more away. What I find interesting is 10-feet roughly corresponds to the distance they can accurately aim and spray their anal gland content. Skunks typically, but not always, give their intended targets visible warning before discharging by first stomping their front feet when they become agitated and then raising their tail. Wise would-be adversaries will heed these warnings and back away. Skunks do have luxurious fur and if it weren't for the repulsive impact of nicking an anal gland while skinning, more trappers would target this fur-bearing species.

I knew these facts about skunks and they all rushed through my mind when I saw the one in my live trap. The memory also immediately came back from over 40-years ago of watching my grandfather release

a similarly captured skunk. I backed away from the skunk and went in the house to gather the necessary equipment. First, I set outside the required "antidote" in case I inadvertently got sprayed. This consists of my 1/2-gallon sprayer, one quart bottle of hydrogen peroxide, 1/4-cup of baking soda, and 1 tablespoon of Dawn dishwashing detergent. (This way I wouldn't have to go near the house and I could mix the concoction and spray myself down, if needed.) While some folks use a blanket, sheet, or towel, I grabbed an old cloth shower curtain I had set aside for this contingency, along with vise-grips. I took a few minutes to watch two YouTube videos, one from Havahart (the major live-trap manufacturer), on how to safely release a captured skunk to verify the memory of my grandfather's process was accurate. (It was!) Before heading out to deal with the skunk, I took 2-minutes to do a rehearsal on one of my other live traps. This consisted of slowly covering the trap (the easier part) and then opening the spring-loaded door and securing it with vise-grips, while the skunk is on the other side of the cloth (the harder part).

I went back out and stopped roughly 12-feet from the caged skunk. Holding the shower curtain at arms-length, so I could just see over the top, I advanced towards the back of the cage at an extremely slow pace. I spoke to the skunk in a soft, calm manner as I approached. I watched the skunk for any agitated behavior, which it never exhibited. If it did, the protocol is to completely freeze and remain absolutely motionless with the shower curtain held out in front, since they typically have short attention spans and will ignore you within 30-seconds. It took roughly 90-seconds to move forward very deliberately before I had the entire cage covered from back to front. With the shower curtain covering and calming the skunk, I carefully pulled up the latch and moved back the spring-loaded armature, before securing the open door with vise-grips. Having completed this tedious task, I backed away. As will happen, the calmed skunk curled up and slept in the now open cage for almost an hour before departing. When I moved the empty trap, I saw the skunk had been digging up an adjacent yellow-jacket colony and probably went in the trap to get a better digging angle, not eat the sweet baits. I recently had to repeat the entire process on another skunk on Sep. 4 and now you know how to safely do it, too! **God Bless, Be Safe, and Great Outdoors!**

DEAR PAW'S CORNER: My two cats, Mitsy and Bitsy, got along well for nearly five years. Bitsy is 11 years old, about six years older than Mitsy. In the past couple of months, they squall and squabble with each other every time they're in the same room. What is going on, and how do I stop it? – Cara C., Albuquerque, New Mexico

DEAR CARA: Take both of your cats to the veterinarian as soon as an appointment is available. Because the behavior just recently started after years of tranquility, a health issue could be at the root of their fighting. Senior cats are especially likely to develop conditions that cause them to be cranky or more territorial than usual. Pain from arthritis or other conditions can be a big factor in making Bitsy irritable, tired and just not in the mood to hang out with Mitsy. Likewise, Mitsy could be developing a medical condition; it's best to rule out physical problems in both cats. Once their health has been assessed and treatment, if necessary, started, then the hard work of reconciling the two can begin. Keep the cats separated at first – on opposite sides of the house, if possible, in closed rooms. Each day, reintroduce them by placing a small plate

The 9/11 Memorial

Among the more indelible images to emerge on September 11, 2001 was the sight of two planes crashing into the North and South Towers of the World Trade Center. Still photos and video footage of those planes flying into the Twin Towers were the first images of the attacks many Americans saw, and no one who watched events unfold that morning will ever forget those images.

Though both the North and South Towers fell on that day, today the site where each tower once stood is a serene retreat in the bustling lower Manhattan neighborhood that was shaken to its core on the day of the attacks. The 9/11 Memorial was designed by architect Michael Arad and landscape architect Peter Walker. The 9/11 Memorial and Museum notes that Arad and Walker's proposal was chosen in a design competition that featured 5,201 submissions from 63 countries.

The 9/11 Memorial is located on the western side of the formal World Trade Center where the Twin Towers once stood. Two enormous reflecting pools are part of the Memorial Plaza, which is where the North and South Towers once stood. The pools feature the two largest man-made waterfalls in North America. Around the edges of the pools, the names of people who were killed in the 9/11 attacks in New York, the Pentagon, on Flight 93, and in the 1993 bombing at the World Trade Center are etched in bronze.

In recognition of the crash sites, 400 swamp white oak trees were selected from nurseries located in New York, Pennsylvania and near Washington, D.C. These trees are located throughout the Memorial Plaza, providing a peaceful respite separate from the surrounding city. The Memorial Plaza also includes one Callery pear tree. That tree was discovered at Ground Zero weeks after the attacks and it was severely damaged. The tree, now known as the Survivor Tree, was nursed back to health by members of the New York City Parks and Recreation Department and returned to the World Trade Center site in 2010, where it still stands as an enduring symbol of resilience and perseverance.

The 9/11 Memorial is free and open daily from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. More information about the 9/11 Memorial and the 9/11 Memorial and Museum can be found at www.911memorial.org. TF219258

The Flight 93 National Memorial

At 10:03 a.m. on September 11, 2001, the last of four planes that were hijacked earlier that morning crashed into a field near the town of Shanksville, Pennsylvania. The people behind the 9/11 attacks later claimed the hijackers who commandeered the plane intended to crash it into the U.S. Capitol Building in Washington, D.C., but passengers and crew stormed the cockpit, prompting the hijackers to crash the plane into the field, which is less than 20 minutes' flying time to Washington, D.C.

The efforts of passengers and crew onboard Flight 93 were nothing short of heroic. Though everyone aboard the flight perished in the crash, the attack on the U.S. Capitol was thwarted, saving untold number of lives. All passengers and crew on board Flight 93 were awarded a Congressional Gold Medal on September 11, 2014.

The Flight 93 National Memorial is located in Stonycreek Township in Somerset County, Pennsylvania, roughly two miles north of Shanksville. The memorial was opened to family members of the victims on September 10, 2015, and is now open to the public seven days a week, 365 days a year from sunrise to sunset, though visitors are urged to contact the Memorial in advance due to potential restrictions or closures related to the COVID-19 pandemic.

In September 2005, the Flight 93 Advisory Commission, which included family members of the victims as well as design and art professionals and community

and national leaders, chose a design proposal submitted by Paul Murdoch Architects and Nelson Byrd Woltz Architects from among 1,100 entries.

The Flight 93 National Memorial includes the Tower of Voices, a 93-foot-tall musical instrument that holds 40 wind chimes, one to represent each of the 40 passengers and crew members who perished in the crash. The tower is located on an oval concrete plaza that includes two curved concrete benches facing the opening of the tower. The tower is surrounded by concentric rings of white pines and deciduous plantings. A live webcam of the Tower of Voices can be viewed at <https://www.flight93friends.org/plan-your-visit/webcams>.

Visitors to the Flight 93 National Memorial also can visit the Memorial Plaza. The Memorial Plaza features the Wall of Names, which is made up of 40 white polished marble stones inscribed with the names of the passengers and crew who were aboard Flight 93 on 9/11. The Memorial Plaza extends one-quarter mile alongside the area where Flight 93 crashed. Visitors can walk along the Memorial Plaza and view the impact site, including a grove of eastern hemlock trees that were damaged by the crash. A gap in the tree line is still visible and serves as a lasting "scar" of the crash.

The Pentagon Memorial

At 9:37 a.m. on September 11, 2001, five hijackers crashed American Airlines Flight 77 into the Pentagon in Arlington County, Virginia. All 53 passengers and six crew members perished in the crash, and an additional 125 military and civilian personnel on the ground were killed in the fire caused by the crash.

The hijacking of Flight 77 was part of the broader attack on 9/11, which remains the deadliest terrorist attack in world history. The Pentagon Memorial was created to honor the 184 people whose lives were lost at the Pentagon on 9/11, as well as their families and all those who sacrifice to protect and preserve the freedom of Americans.

The design of the Pentagon Memorial was developed by architects Julie Beckman and Keith Kaseman. Their design was chosen from 1,100 submissions.

The Pentagon Memorial sits on two acres of land just outside where Flight 77 struck the building. The memorial includes 184 benches that are dedicated to each of the victims. The benches are organized in a timeline of their ages, stretching from the youngest victim, 3-year-old Dana Falkenberg, to the oldest, 71-year-old John Yamnicky. Each bench is engraved with a victim's name and arches over a shallow reflecting pool of water, lit from below. The benches for the passengers who were aboard the plane at the time of the crash are positioned so visitors will face the sky when reading the victim's name. The benches dedicated to the victims who were inside the building are positioned so their names and the Pentagon are in the same view.

A curved wall known as the Age Wall also is a significant part of the memorial. The wall increases in height from 3 inches to 71 inches to represent the ages of the victims.

Eighty-five paperbark maple trees were clustered throughout the memorial, and these trees feature foliage that changes to orange and red each fall. The trees will eventually grow to 30 feet, providing a canopy of shade over the memorial.

The Pentagon Memorial is free and open seven days a week year-round, though visitors are urged to contact the Memorial in advance due to potential restrictions or closures related to the COVID-19 pandemic. Make Kale Chips With Kids

While kale chip recipes abound, I found the best, foolproof technique from Tricia Cornell, mom of two, freelance writer and author of the book "Eat More Vegetables: Making the Most of Your Seasonal Produce" (Minnesota Historical Society Press). She has the kale-chip-making technique down to a science. "When my kids clamor for kale chips, who am I to refuse?" she said as her 7-year-old old son Arlo chopped up the kale, and 9-year-old Nora grated Parmesan for the chips that would accompany their hamburger sliders supper. "I want the chips to be tasty and crispy every time we make them," she said. Pick up a bunch at your local market and enjoy making and tasting these light, crunchy treats with your kids.

CHEESY KALE CHIPS - Makes 4 cups
1 large bunch kale (12 ounces),
both Lacinato and curly kale work well.
1 tablespoon olive or canola oil
1/4 cup finely grated Parmesan
1/2 teaspoon kosher salt
1/2 teaspoon freshly ground
black pepper or 1/2 teaspoon pepper flakes

Here's the fun:

1. Heat oven to 400 F.
2. Trim off the long, tough center stems from kale and discard. Slice leaves into 1- to 2-inch pieces and place in a large bowl. Pour oil, cheese, salt and pepper over kale, and massage kale well with your hands, making sure every piece is covered, but not dripping, with oil.
3. Line 2 baking sheets with parchment paper and spread kale in a single layer. Place in oven and immediately reduce heat to 250 F.
4. Bake about 20 minutes, until crisp, stirring kale and turning pans halfway through. It's important to keep an eagle eye toward the end; you want crisp, not brown.
5. When completely cool, serve. If there are any leftovers, store in airtight container up to three days.

Variation: Barbecue Kale Chips - Omit Parmesan and pepper. Stir 1 teaspoon "pimenton de la vera" (smoked Spanish paprika) and 1/2 teaspoon sugar into the salt before adding.
