





brewer's yeast is safe for cats and dogs. I disagree. I found several more articles online that say pets can be allergic to brewer's yeast. What do you say about that? - Carla L, via email

DEAR CARLA: Pet owners should always research and evaluate the risks of any supplement for their pets. Brewer's veast is a mainstay for owners trying to find a natural flea control treatment, and others swear that its blend of B vitamins makes their pets healthier.

It has been found that brewer's yeast created for humans often contains ingredients like garlic and onions that are downright toxic to pets. Owners should purchase only brewer's yeast formulated for dogs or cats, as PetMD notes (www.petmd.com/ dog/nutrition/brewers-yeast-dogs-understandingbenefits-and-risks).

Here are some other tips for picking the right brewer's veast:

- Give only the amount recommended for your pet's size.

- Brewer's veast that has been "de-bittered" lacks chromium, a mineral that helps regulate blood sugar in humans but hasn't been studied in dogs.

- Read the label carefully: Some brewer's yeast for pets contains garlic, which can be toxic, especially for smaller pets.

- Consider a brewer's yeast that includes omega-3 oils for added benefits.

- This supplement can add up to 80 calories to your pet's meal. It can also cause excess gas.

Some pets really are allergic to the yeast itself, though. Avoid giving brewer's yeast to dogs with known yeast allergy, who have digestive illnesses like colitis, or who are immunocompromised. Always monitor your pet for new behaviors or symptoms after giving them any new supplement.

Place the cinnamon sticks, cloves, allspice berries, orange peel and lemon peel in the center of a washed square of cheesecloth; fold up the sides of the cheesecloth to enclose the bundle, then tie it up with a length of kitchen string. Drop the spice bundle into the cider mixture. Place the saucepan over moderate heat for 5 to 10 minutes, or until the cider is very hot but not boiling. Remove the cider from the heat. Discard the spice bundle. Ladle the cider into big cups or mugs, adding a fresh cinnamon stick to each serving if desired.

I know, English class may or may not bring back good memories from your school days. In fact, you may or may not have been paying attention when your English teacher explained the difference between an acronym (a pronounced word formed by the first letter of each word in a phrase, such as ASAP – "As Soon As Possible") and an acrostic (where you take each letter of a word and make a sentence or word which has some meaning related to the original word). By those definitions, I have to say I used two weak acrostics in my title for this piece, both using the word FALL. Now, you might ask, why would he do that? Because Fall officially starts on Wed., Sep. 22, 2021 at 3:20 PM in the Northern Hemisphere when the Sun is exactly above the Equator, giving us roughly equal 12-hours of daylight and darkness, and Fall is officially by far my favorite season of the year! I love the 91-days each year between Sep. 22 and Dec. 21 as the temperatures cool, the leaves wonderfully change colors, and outdoor opportunities abound!

Now, my bringing up English class and the things you studied there may be a sore subject for some, but I'll bet something that might bring a smile to your face from your school days is the thought of a hall pass. You know, that simple piece of paper from a teacher, administrator, or secretary giving you permission to wander the empty halls while everyone else was stuck in class. There was a certain feeling of freedom and exhilaration that came with receiving a hall pass. Well, I want you to read this piece and consider this your official "Fall Pass" to get outdoors as much as possible over the upcoming 91-day period we call Autumn or Fall, and I encourage you to enjoy participating in as many outdoor activities as you can possibly fit in the time available! I know I will be all over the map, literally and figuratively, so allow me to share ideas on the wide variety of outdoor opportunities we can all pick from to fill our days.

First of all, everything seems to go better in the Fall with more comfortable temperatures, less humidity, fewer bugs, and the ever-present, awe-inspiring backdrop of the vibrant colors of the changing leaves. Some of the maples and staghorn sumacs are already starting to turn red as a prelude of what's to come in the upcoming weeks as we move into October. Fall is an ideal time to get outdoors and walk more, hike more, bike more, camp more, canoe more, kayak more, geocache more, and do everything more

that gets you outside to enjoy the fresh air and remarkable colors of Penn's Woods. Please allow me to encourage you while walking, hiking, biking, or doing anything else out in the woods this Fall to wear fluorescent orange whenever possible, since it is also hunting season and with multiple compatible uses of our abundant public lands, it's imperative everyone is as proactively safety-conscience as possible.

Second, Fall is an ideal time for family-related outdoor activities, which are as equally enjoyable for adults as they are for children. These outdoor activities include, but are not limited to: apple and pumpkin picking, corn mazes, hayrides, going on a leisurely drive for some colorful canopy observing, and even leaf raking. Granted, playing in the leaf piles may be more fun for the children than for the adults, who will probably have to rake them up a second time, but remember the positive, you're making memories as a family. Cooler temperatures also seem to be an ideal time to sit around the campfire or a backyard fire pit, and the darkness just seems to make everyone's eyes turn upward for a little stargazing on a clear Autumn night. Take time for some stimulating wildlife-watching with your family. Whether that's traveling up to the PA Wilds Region to see the elk, heading out locally to spotlight deer some night, or looking skyward to observe migrating raptors, waterfowl, and assorted songbirds. This year, I plan on expanding my foraging efforts for wild edibles, such as puffballs, acorns, hickory nuts, and black walnuts.

Finally, the biggest competitors for my time each Fall are hunting and fishing. The fish know Winter is coming and they gorge themselves in preparation for leaner times. Fall is an excellent time to catch smallmouth bass, steelhead, catfish, and a wide variety of other species. My only limitation is how much time I'll permit my fishing to take away from my hunting efforts. Fall in my mind equals hunting season and I have to be careful to check which seasons are open for what species when, since the days seem to fly by at a faster pace each Fall. There are a few species huntable right now, such as Canada geese, doves, and squirrels, and deer become legal quarry for archers very soon. So much to do each Autumn and so much to potentially write about. I can hardly wait to do as much as possible outdoors in 2021. If you want my humble opinion, "Fall is the best time for it all!"
