Staying Inbounds When You're Out Deer Hunting (Part 1 of 2)

end and Black Friday are already here. It's the time of year when everything seems to kick into high gear. There's Christmas preparations, our PA regular firearms deer season opens tomorrow (Nov. 27), and for sports fans, there's a steady stream of football games. Have you noticed how most fans pay little attention to the officials until one of them blows a call and it becomes the focus? Within milliseconds, players and the football come together and an official must immediately decide if the receiver made a catch and came down inbounds or out-of-bounds. Have you ever thought it from the official's perspective? They're trying their best to make the right call at "game speed" and then everything pauses for a video review. There, the play gets slowed down, magnified, and talked about, while being broadcast to millions of viewers and simultaneously shown repeatedly on the stadium's jumbotron. Regardless of the outcome, some fans will be upset and talk about it for days. You know what I find interesting, typi-

cally the fans who spew the most vitrio about bad officiating are ones who definitely don't want any kind of close scrutiny put on their own lives. Let's imagine that during this year's firearms deer season each hunter's actions were recorded, video reviewed, and examined in excruciating detail to decide if they stayed inbounds when they harvested their deer or assisted in someone else's deer harvest. Hunters like to tell stories and after years of being told them or overhearing them at the gun counter, in checkout lines, in restaurants, at church, and in countless other places; I'm convinced at least 10% of PA's annual deer harvest is out-of-bounds and thousands of hunters would have to answer for their actions, if there was video review. Allow me to share some common situations where individuals step out-of-bounds, so hunters can remember what's right and nonhunters can understand who plays by the rules and who doesn't. (I'll include the page out of the 2021-22 PA Hunting & Trapping Digest as a reference, since the PA Game Commission makes/enforces the rules.)

1. Electronic Communication Devices (Page 16) - In the age when most folks have cell phones or small handheld radios (for use where there is no cell service). it's tempting to call/text deer coming their way, and that by the rules is illegal and unethical. You can use your communication device to

Hard to believe Thanksgiving week- ask if your buddy is at their stand or if they want to meet back at the truck for lunch, but the instant you provide any information on the presence or location of live game/wildlife; you've stepped out-of-bounds when it comes to fair chase. Unfortunately, I hear other hunters talking about participating in this illegal practice on a fairly regular basis and it seems to be getting worse.

2. Baiting (Page 16) - While Walmart and other retailers sell deer corn, electronic/gravity feeders, mineral rocks & blocks, and a myriad of food attractants (corn, apple, etc.) since they are legal in other states where those major retailers do business (i.e.: Ohio); those baits are all illegal and unethical to use within 30-days of hunting an area, here in PA. If you bow hunt a spot, any baits had to be removed by Sep. 3; and if you never bow hunted, but only rifle hunt an area, the bait had to be completely removed by Oct. 30. (Which includes removing residue that leached into the soil from minerals getting rained on, by digging up the ground.) This rule does not apply to cultivated food plots. If someone is deer hunting in a location where there is bait out, even if it is private property they own, it is poaching plain-and-simple.

3. Private Lands (Page 19) and Safety Zones (Page 18) - A hunting license does not give you permission to trespass on private property without the landowner's consent, either to hunt or retrieve wounded game. Several times, I've heard hunters talk about "sneaking onto the Back Forty at so-and-so's place" to hunt and that's out-of-bounds. Similarly, Safety Zones exist for a reason, which is 150-yards around any occupied structure without permission of the occupants, when it comes to firearms. They are also "hands off" for wildlife (read the rule for yourself), so sending a hunter through a Safety Zone with or without their firearm to drive out game is a violation, unless you have the structure's occupants' permission.

The late, great coach John Wooden is quoted as saying, "The true test of a man's character is what he does when no one else is watching." Now that you know a little better what our PA deer hunting rules are and some that are commonly violated, you can do a little "Monday morning quarterbacking" when your family, friends, co-workers, or strangers tell hunting stories and you'll have a clear picture on the inyour family member or friend about tegrity (or lack thereof) of the person you're dealing with. 
