Cultivating Curiosity in the Young and in the Young at Heart

question, but how much have you changed at your very core from when you were a child until now as an adult? I'm not talking about obvious physical changes that come with physical growth and maturity. I'd like you to give this question some real thought and do a simple exercise. Take a piece of paper and in one column on the left side list six adjectives that best describe childhood you and then in a second column on the right list six adjectives that now accurately describe adult you. Regardless of whether 15-years, 30-years, 60-years, or even more time has gone by between then (childhood you) and now (adult you); are any of the same words in both columns of the paper? Are some of the words almost opposites? When you look over your list, do you like who you've become? Are there childhood qualities you wonder why you've lost them and you'd possibly like to get them back?

Let me be very clear. There are no right or wrong answers to this contemplative exercise. However, it does shed some light on who you are as a person and possibly may have some bearing on the education you pursued, the career path you've taken, and the choices you've made in life. Allow me to share one word that made it onto both colsimple exercise myself. That word is Curious, which by definition means, "eager to know or learn something". Now, curious may have made some folks' childhood six adjective lists, but I wonder how often it dropped off their adult six adjective lists. It seems like curiosity is something we recognize and value in children, but frequently dismiss as we get older. I have to admit, curiosity is something that got me started in outdoor writing and inspires me to constantly seek out new places, things, and experiences, and then write about them for others to ponder.

Allow me to share something that fueled my curiosity as a child. Starting about the time I was 4-years old, so we're talking 1967 and on, my favorite TV show was Mutual of Omaha's Wild Kingdom, which transported viewers to wild places around the world. Every Sunday evening at 7 PM on NBC, host Marlin Perkins would narrate, while his "sidekick" Jim Fowler would do most of the difficult fieldwork, like wrestle an alligator or anaconda. In a park, or the backyard are a healthy my young mind, I was convinced that respite for individuals of all ages. Who when Marlin eventually retired and Jim knows what you'll find? Stay curious, moved up into the top spot as narrator, my friends! God Bless, Be Safe, and I would be the one who got to do the "hands-on" tasks with the wild animals.

Now, this might sound like a strange Did that childhood fantasy eventually propel me into majoring in Wildlife Science at Penn State? Possibly, it had something to do with my educational decision. However, I can tell you that from 4-years old and on, I was constantly catching and observing toads, frogs, crayfish, minnows, turtles, tadpoles, salamanders, butterflies, lightning bugs, hellgrammites, honey bees. worms, and whatever else I could find and usually place in a glass jar or plastic container (with holes punched in the lid), and then release after showing my family and friends. I would also collect mementos of my trips into the woods, so interesting leaves, rocks, shells, nuts, and other objects went home for subsequent identification.

My purpose behind sharing my curiosity-fueled outdoor ramblings as a youngster is to implore you as an adult with children, grandchildren, nieces & nephews, and other youngsters in vour life, to take time now that warmer weather is upon us to let their curiosity run rampant. When was the last time you waded in a small stream, turning over rocks looking for crayfish and other invertebrates? Why not do some bird-watching or wildlife-watching, and help the littles ones learn to identify the various species? Consider watching an active bird's nest from an appropriate umns of my list when I completed this distance, so your children can see the nest, adult bird(s), eggs, and possibly young chicks; and gain an appreciation for their habitat and life cycle. You too can catch, observe, and release various species of insects, amphibians, and fish much like I did. Take a few moments during the day to watch the clouds, letting their imaginations determine what certain clouds look like. Then at night, do some star-gazing and moon observing, while keeping an eye out for satellites passing overhead. Other curiosity inspired activities children and adults can pursue together include: metaldetecting, finding arrowheads, locating fossils, and the identification of plants, trees, birds, insects, rocks, shells, and other natural objects at a level of detail that is age appropriate. A magnifying glass can be a magnificent tool in the hands of a youngster to unlock the wonders of an ant hill or other insects.






