recommended a 100% meat dog treat, which is a great high-value snack. Look for a product like this in the pet store's fresh food aisle. Peanut butter is another fave among dogs. One of my dogs is a huge fan of Doritos. (I have to hide them.)

Here's some more tips for giving oral medication or drops to a dog or cat:

- Work off some of your pet's energy beforehand. Take the dog for a walk or have your cat play with a toy.
- Make sure the pet is held safely. Place the cat on your lap and cradle your arm around their body, placing your hand on their chest. Have the dog sit or lie down at your feet (or in your lap), facing forward or to the side.
- Stay calm and positive. Give your pet a small treat while being encouraging and petting them.
- Give the medication as quickly as possible. Don't force or rush the process, but gently open their mouth and pop the pill in as far back as possible, then rub the underside of their jaw and throat to encourage swallowing. If giving eyedrops, gently lift one eyelid and put in the drop, then repeat on the other side.

Plowshare Christmas

Read: Isaiah 2:1-4

They shall beat their swords into plowshares . . . ; neither shall they learn war anymore. —Isaiah 2:4

In his book Christmas 1945, Matthew Litt tells about the first peacetime Christmas celebration in the US after World War II. The New York Daily News alerted readers to expect a fleet of warships in New York Harbor: "Christmas Day will find a mighty armada, consisting of 4 battleships, 6 carriers, 7 cruisers, and 24 destroyers." But instead of waging war, the military ships hosted 1,000 needy children.

The children's measurements had been taken previously so that perfectly fitted navy-blue coats and woolen caps would be gift-wrapped and awaiting them aboard the ships. These vessels of war had been transformed into carriers of compassion.

The prophet Isaiah predicted a future day of Christ's reign of peace on this earth: "They shall beat their swords into plowshares, and their spears into pruning hooks; nation shall not lift up sword against nation, neither shall they learn war anymore" (2:4). Christmastime serves as a reminder that the Prince of Peace will ultimately bring a time of global calm and compassion. As we celebrate the first coming of the Prince of Peace and wait for His second coming, we are reminded of our privilege to serve as His "carriers of compassion."

Lord, You have come and brought peace, and I long to share Your compassion everywhere I go. Thank You that this world will know ultimate peace when You return. Amen.





Nothing says comfort, security and home like an old-fashioned meal of meatloaf and mashed potatoes. Try this tasty supper with your family, or better yet, invite another family over to enjoy this generous-sized recipe of Outside-Inside Meatloaf.

We call it the all-in-one vegetable/potato/meatloaf because, when you slice the main dish, the kids discover that everything is hidden inside - everything, that is, except the salad and bread, which your guests could bring to complete this fabulous "let's get together" meal.

It's also the perfect solution for using Thanksgiving meal leftovers. Extra portions of mashed potatoes, peas and corn are the perfect ingredients to complete this recipe. Even the day-old dinner rolls are useful. They're all part of the mix.

OUTSIDE-INSIDE MEATLOAF MASH-UP

Serves 8

- 2 pounds lean ground beef
- 2 eggs, slightly beaten
- 2 cups fresh or packaged breadcrumbs
- 2 tablespoons tomato paste
- 1 tablespoon Worcestershire sauce
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 teaspoon freshly ground pepper
- 3 cups prepared mashed potatoes
- 1 cup cooked peas or corn
- 1/2 cup grated cheddar cheese
- Ketchup or mustard for drizzling on top



Preheat oven to 350 degrees Fahrenheit. In a large bowl, with very clean hands, let your child thoroughly mix together the meat, eggs, breadcrumbs, tomato paste, Worcestershire sauce and seasonings.

Place mix on a large sheet of parchment or wax paper and form a 9-inch-by-12-inch rectangle. Use a rolling pin to make it even and smooth.

Spread the potatoes over the meat with a spatula, leaving a 1-inch border all around. Top with vegetables and cheese.

With adult assistance, your child can roll up the large meatloaf lengthwise, lifting up the paper to get it started. Remove paper and place the meatloaf seam-side down on a foil-lined baking pan. Pat it together firmly, pinch ends closed and drizzle ketchup or mustard on top.

Bake uncovered for 1 to 1 1/4 hours, or until completely done. Remove from oven and let rest for 10 minutes before transferring to a large serving platter for slicing.

Proper Recycling & Waste Management

Understanding the Cost of Waste & Recycling

A Guide to Doing it right in Lawrence and Mercer Counties

Our trash gets no respect. Paying to get rid of something we no longer want or have need for is one of the last things we want to do. Many people believe that their trash and recycling bill are expensive and some people are still under the wrong impression that their recyclables are valuable and that recycling should be free. This Fact Sheet was designed to help you understand the basics of curbside waste and recycling collection programs.

I don't generate a lot of trash. Why should I pay that much or subscribe to service?

It doesn't matter if you put out four bags a week or one bag a month, the trash you generate is the cheapest expense associated with your bill. The hauler's fixed costs are the greatest expense. Labor, equipment, and fuel, among other things are expensive. If your service level includes trash picked up weekly and your recyclables bi-weekly, your hauler is required to be at your house faithfully to provide that service. If you do not put out any trash or recyclables on your scheduled collection day, your hauler must show up and still incurs the cost associated with getting their equipment and workers to your home.

Curbside Waste & Recycling Collection

Collection is available through subscription services or municipal contracts. With subscription services, residents are free to select their hauler of choice. In municipalities with contracts, residents, and sometimes businesses, are required to use the contracted hauler. As a third option, residents in areas without municipal contracts, may choose to haul their own waste to a permitted landfill or transfer station.

Pros and Cons of Contracted Service

Customers of municipal contracts typically enjoy uniform programming at a significantly reduced cost. Using one contractor means everyone has the same service, less vehicle noise, and roadway wear and tear. Municipal contracts may also include spring/fall cleanups and/or other special collection opportunities. The reason for the reduced cost is that when the hauler knows how many homes need service, they know their precise cost per home. Some haulers refer to this as a "base fee" which ensures that their costs are covered, even if a customer doesn't put out any materials. Ideal contracts require all households to participate which keeps the cost down for everyone. Although rare, a municipality may also require its business to participate in the contract. The primary disadvantage to a municipal contract is that residents do not have the ability to choose their own hauler.

Pros and Cons of Subscription Service

Subscription-based residents have the freedom to pick their own waste and recycling provider and can pay for additional services such as bulky item collection or electronics recycling. Cons to subscription programs include: fees that may be more than twice as much as those paying for a municipal contract; additional noise and roadway wear and tear from multiple companies running multiple vehicles at different times; and differences among service providers. The higher fees with subscription services are the result of haulers not having consistent customer bases and customers that may be spread out over an area versus a dense contracted area.



Bag Programs

Although rare, some haulers offer service through the purchase of special bags. This type of service is an inexpensive option for people who do not generate a lot of trash. Additionally, since the service is bag-based a person using this service can put multiple bags at a time that are the result of a large gathering or home cleanout. Trash in recyclables is a problem often cited as plaguing bag programs because people put trash into recycling bins to avoid paying for additional bags. Other cons include not having recycling as part of the service or paying additional for recycling if it is offered (which can be a detriment to recycling) and a loss of revenues for the hauler unless a base fee is included. Bag programs can also contribute to a community's illegal dumping problem when residents dump their material instead of purchasing more bags.

Illegal Dumping and Theft of Services

When trash and recyclables aren't managed properly, there can be significant problems that are expensive for municipalities and damaging to our health, economy, and environment.

Illegal dumping and littering are on-going problems for many communities. Potentially hazardous items, including electronics and chemicals, can directly damage our environment and contaminate our soil and drinking water.

Illegal dumping and littering is also expensive. It's much cheaper to manage trash properly the first time than pick it up after it's been illegally tossed along a roadway. Keep Pennsylvania Beautiful has documented that it can cost up to \$1,000 to clean one ton of illegally dumped trash. When done right the first time, it only costs \$40 to \$60 a ton to take it to one of our local facilities.

Theft of services results when trash is placed into a dumpster (usually a business dumpster) without permission. A business paying for dumpster service is paying for the "space" in the dumpster. That "space" is stolen when trash is illegally placed in the dumpster. This can be an expensive problem for a business, especially if hazardous materials such as electronics are dumped, and is frequently reported in municipalities with subscription-based or bag services.

Public Perceptions and Attitudes

As a society our own attitudes are often the biggest obstacle to a good waste management program. We are conditioned to spend money on items we want but reluctant to spend money to properly dispose of that item when its useful life is over. Is that monthly trash bill really expensive? In our area, the cost of a single month of cable/satellite or cell phone service can pay for almost a full year of trash and recycling collection in a municipality with a contract.

Outdoor Opportunities By COL (Ret.) Grey D. Berrier II

Making Certain You Return Home Safely at the End of Each Excursion

Sit still or move around? That's the perpetual question hunters ask themselves this time of year, since it tremendously impacts how they will dress from their headgear down to their footwear. If I know I'm going to sit completely still in a tree stand from 6 AM until 5:30 PM, I know I'll need to wear twice as many, or even more, layers of clothing on my entire body than when I'm steadily moving and generating body heat. In the Army, we would deal with a similar quandary when it came to packing lists, especially when daytime temperatures were above freezing and at night the thermometer dropped below 32-degrees. In Alaska, going to the field for ten-days at a time, it was summarized by the soldiers' wisdom, "Travel light, freeze at night". The bottom line is, when you know you will be outdoors for an extended period, you can make conscious decisions about what, or what not, to bring along to remain comfortable and safe.

However, not everything always goes according to plan. Sometimes bad things happen to good people. What if while hunting alone and stepping over a log on a hillside, your feet slip out from under you in three inches of wet snow and you severely sprain your knee on a rock, to the point where you have to decide whether it is more prudent to remain in place and wait for help or attempt to crawl out on your own for over a mile? The decision you make may go back to how you started your day at home.

My wife and I have a routine. When I get up early and leave the house well before daylight, I always leave her a note informing her what location I'll be hunting, where I plan on parking, and when I plan on returning home. Mary put a magnet on the range hood above our stove and my note goes there in a prominent spot, so she sees it whenever she comes into the kitchen. Additionally, I've printed out maps of my many hunting spots and I leave the appropriate one on the kitchen table with my parking spot and hunting stand(s) identified, along with notes on any anticipated routes of movement (i.e.: hunting this entire 3-mile creek drainage in a counter-clockwise direction). I don't care if you are hunting, hiking, back-packing, mountain biking, trail running, cross-country skiing, or doing whatever else outdoors, it's important you let someone responsible know where you'll be and when you'll be back, so they can inform authorities to initiate a search and potential rescue, if the need arises. Letting someone know where you'll be hunt-

ing and when you'll be back, also applies at hunting camp; since the "Big Woods" of the Allegheny National Forest, our vast PA state forests, and many PA state game lands span thousands of acres, numerous drainages, and contain hundreds of miles of dirt forest roads. Your odds of having a mere inconvenience and not a potential catastrophe go up significantly when someone knows your plans.

Recently, I've been noting a trend of seeing more and more trail runners and mountain bikers further back in the woods on many PA state forests, state parks, and state game lands. While I'm all for multi-use of our public lands, I get a little concerned when those runners and cyclists are dressed lightly for their high-exertion activity and have no means of keeping warm, if something were to happen. Occasionally, trail runners go down on snow and mountain bikers crash, and suddenly finding yourself injured and miles from your vehicle in freezing conditions wearing a light running jacket, exercise pants, and running shoes can be a recipe for potential disaster. This very scenario played out last week in New Hampshire when a 20-year-old Massachusetts woman went for a quick hike with minimal clothing and equipment in the White Mountains on Nov. 20, and tragically her remains were not found by searchers until Nov. 23, due to the remote terrain, high winds, very cold temperatures (0-degrees at night), and limited visibility.

If you are an outdoorsperson or have a family member, friend, or loved one who is, may I make a heartfelt recommendation on a potential Christmas gift to yourself or someone else, which is inexpensive, light-weight, and potentially life-saving. Part of my outdoor kit, especially when temperatures are below 55-degrees and hypothermia is an ever-present threat, is a survival or space blanket. The one I carry comes in a 3.5-inch x 5.5-inch package less than an inch thick, weighs a mere 3.5-ounces, and measures 5-feet x 8-feet when opened. The Large size is rated for one or two people, has a shiny aluminum foil-like inside that reflects up to 90% of body heat, and a bright orange exterior, which is highly visible to rescuers. They can be found at sporting goods stores or online for \$8 to \$10. They are an investment in a potentially life-saving piece of gear for yourself or an unfortunate someone you may encounter afield. Help insure a safe return from your next outdoor excursion! **God Bless, Be Safe, and Great Outdoors! ©WBB 2022**
