



DEAR PAW'S CORNER: I am wondering how I can get an emotional support animal. I noticed a woman in the local pharmacy today whose dog wore a harness with "ESA" printed on it. Is there an organization that supplies these animals to people who need them? – Curious in Daytona Beach

DEAR CURIOUS: You'll find many websites offering ESA certifications or advice on getting an ESA prescription from your doctor. But there is no single organization for ESAs, and there is not one group I know of that supplies them on request (certainly, none that I would recommend).

At this time, the way to "get" an emotional support animal is to adopt or purchase a pet. You are solely responsible for the care and training of this animal – dog, cat, rabbit or bird. It's part of your family. From there, you can designate your pet as an ESA by doing the following:

Ask your doctor or mental health professional for a letter stating that the presence of your pet is needed for your emotional health.

That's it. That's all that is needed to designate a pet as an ESA.

Now, keep in mind that an emotional support animal does not qualify for the same considerations as a service animal. While many stores allow ESAs on the premises (leashed and well-behaved), other businesses do not. Airlines will not accommodate them, for example.

The advantage of an ESA designation/prescription is in housing. Properties must waive pet restrictions and fees for owners of emotional support animals, under the Fair Housing Act.

They Are Our PA State Parks -So Visit Early and Visit Often!

land owner? Here in PA, we are all truly in 2023! They are not just for picnickblessed. 16.3% of the Commonwealth's land area is public land (that's 1/6 of retreats, waiting to be experienced the entire state)! As a PA citizen, those lands are your lands, just waiting to be don't just visit the four PA state parks explored, enjoyed, respected, and cherished. Many folks do not realize PA has one of the largest state park systems in one or more new PA state parks elsethe entire nation, currently comprised of 124 state parks totaling over 300,000 acres. Back on Sep. 27, 2022, then-Governor Tom Wolf announced the addition of PA's three newest parks, which are currently in the planning phase in Chester, Wyoming, and York Counties. Our enviable state park system owes a lot of its success to a true visionary, a name you might recognize, Maurice are growing in popularity at state and K. Goddard. (Yes, the namesake of the beautiful state park in neighboring Mercer County, which encompasses Lake Wilhelm.) Maurice Goddard (1912-1995) was a WWII veteran, a previously worked at Yellow Creek Penn State Professor, and the driving and Pymatuning State Parks. She had force behind the creation of 45 PA state parks, while he served for 24-years under six governors as a cabinet officer, first as the Secretary of the PA Dept. of Forests and Waters (1955-70) and then as the Secretary of the renamed focused on park habitat management PA Dept. of Environmental Resources (1970-79).

It was Maurice Goddard's vision to establish a PA state park within areas, and forests help a wide assort-25-miles of every citizen everywhere in the entire Commonwealth. That is very close to existing under today's PA Dept. of Conservation and Natural Resources (DCNR). It was back in bird boxes, numerous interesting facts July 1995 when the former PA Dept about an assortment of plants (such as of Environmental Resources split into two agencies: DCNR (which manages our state parks and state forests) and the Dept. of Environmental Protection of former agricultural fields/pastures (DEP). If you think about the Weekly now overgrown, and the importance Bargain Bulletin's distribution area, his PA state park accessibility vision pretty much holds true. Lawrence County has McConnells Mill State Park, while Beaver County has Raccoon Creek, Butler County has Moraine, and Mercer has Goddard. All four state parks are very unique and definitely worth visiting. When hearing about the vision to have a state park within 25-miles of every PA resident, many people incorrectly assume Pittsburgh and Alleghenv County are left out of this plan. They forget the land at the tip of the Triangle, where the Allegheny and Monongahela Rivers merge to form the mighty Ohio River, the location of the prominent fountain, is Point State Park and visited by thousands of people every day.

I would encourage every reader to vis-

Do you realize you are an abundant it our PA state parks on a regular basis ing in warmer weather, but year-round Winter, Spring, Summer, and Fall. And closest to home that I mentioned earlier. Broaden your horizons and visit where in the Commonwealth where you've never set foot before. You'll be pleasantly surprised and enjoy seeing new places/things for the first time. Wanting to be a practitioner of what I'm preaching, my wife and I headed up to Goddard State Park back on New Year's Day, Jan. 1, 2023 for their scheduled First Day Hike. (First Day Hikes national parks all across the country to encourage people to get out.)

Our guide was retired DCNR Outdoor Educator, Linda Armstrong, who 19 eager participants for the 90-minute interpreted walk, including Goddard State Park Manager, Mark Scarpitti, along with his wife and children. Linda covered a broad array of outdoor topics for wildlife, stressing that mowed grass fields provide little, if any, benefit for wildlife, while overgrown fields, brushy ment of species. While we walked the trails mowed through the brush, Linda pointed out tracks, trails, scat (yes, wild animal poop), birds' nests, blue goldenrod, Norway spruce, multiflora rose, white pine, red pine, and scotch pine), rock walls which are evidence of small streams with their abundance of aquatic insects. Her facts, stories, and insight kept the attention of participants of all ages on a day when the temperature might have been a distraction. Our PA state parks have outdoor educators who offer a wide variety of outdoor-oriented walks, talks, and activities year-round. You can learn about these many offerings from DCNR's website: www.dcnr.pa.gov If you feel confined, get outdoors and explore/ enjoy our PA state parks, because it's our public land!


