Outdoor Opportunities By COL (Ret.) Grey D. Berrier II

Don't Be Myopic - Allegheny County Can Be Your Outdoor Destination

about the outdoors and the word Allegheny was brought up, I admit my initial thoughts would be of the 197-Kinzua Dam down to The Point in Pittsburgh, which offers extensive paddling opportunities for canoeists and kayakers. However, I recently became reacquainted with Allegheny County as an outdoor recreation destination and had to readjust my thinking only of "The City" as the place to go culture.

Back on Fri., Jan. 13, 2023, I had a 7:30 AM appointment in the South Hills. Afterward, I linked up with our son, Grey III, and we took the Red Line of their Light Rail Transit (the "T") from South Hills Village northbound to Dormont. Just stating a fact here, but as a life-long rural resident, I've taken public transportation in PA less than a dozen times in my entire life (not counting school buses, which were the norm). The only two other times I've ever ridden the "T" were to accompany our son to Penguins and Pirates games. I'm sure it was pretty obvious to other riders I was a "newbie", since I was taking all the sights in as we went down the rails and not one of the masses with their gaze fixed on a smart phone screen. Our destination was the Dor-Stop for a hearty breakfast, since we had seen the restaurant featured on Guy Fieri's Diners, Drive-Ins, and Dives years ago. We ate an excellent breakfast, and while human nature would be to take it easy and let it digest, our desire was to burn those calories as soon as possible.

headed over to the Bethel Branch of the Montour Trail to get in some miles. The Bethel Branch stretches roughly 3.5-miles from Bethel Park in Allegheny County to the main Montour Trail in Peters Township, Washington County. Selected as PA's Best Rails-to-Trails Project in 2017, the Montour Trail follows a path through suburban and rural areas, stretching for over 50-miles, when the Bethel Branch is included. Its cinder surface, much like an older high school track, makes for easy walking, and we saw numerous other folks getting in their steps and exercising their dogs. With temperatures hovering around freezing and the clouds spitting snowflakes and some sleet, we were still somewhat surprised we didn't see anyone on a bicycle during our excursion. We logged just under 7-miles in one-hour and 45-minutes to maintain a 15-minute/mile pace and had a great con-

If we were having a conversation versation the entire time we walked. While we saw numerous birds and several small mammals, the highlight of our trip was seeing three American mile Allegheny River flowing from Robins eating autumn olive berries right along the trail. While it is welldocumented all robins do not migrate south, it was still special to see our first ones of 2023 on Jan. 13!

If you're familiar with PA Hunt & Trapping Regulations, you know our 2022-23 statewide late flintlock season ended on Mon., Jan. 16, 2023. for professional sports, museums, and However, hunters have the opportunity to hunt for 12-additional days, if they travel down to Wildlife Management Unit (WMU) 2B, which includes most of Allegheny County, along with highly-populated, adjacent portions of Beaver, Butler, Washington, and Westmoreland Counties. Knowing the opportunity to pursue white-tailed deer with a flintlock rifle continues through Sat., Jan. 28, 2023, fellow outdoor writer Jerry Bush from Hermitage and I headed down to PA State Game Land 203 on Mon., Jan. 24. Allegheny County's sole state game land, this 1245acre forested tract is located less than a mile west of I-79 in the Wexford area and provides public access to those interested in expanding their hunting seasons by traveling down to WMU 2B. We encountered 2-inches of fresh wet-snow, which clung to every tree. shrub, and plant. The abundant snowcovered brush made for slow-going, but that's the pace you want to move at when you are still-hunting and looking very closely for hidden deer at close and medium range. Wet snow necessitates lock covers to keep your flintlock's action dry and periodic checks After our return trip on the "T", we are the norm to ensure your priming charge has not become "soupy" and nonfunctional from moisture in the air. While we didn't bring a deer home, I was rather surprised to find multiple groves of hemlock trees, a sizeable active beaver dam and lodge with numerous nearby trees in various stages of being gnawed down, and several sizable buck rubs providing evidence of their creators existence in the area. I was somewhat shocked by the absence of traffic noise while we hunted and can only attribute the sense of being in a much more remote area to its rolling hills.



PROPER () RECYCLING COMPOSTING

A Guide to doing it right in Lawrence and Mercer Counties

What is Composting?

Composting is the human intervention in the natural decay process. In nature, this process can take up to two years. We can shorten this process to six to seven weeks by adjusting and maintaining the moisture, oxygen, and Nitrogen content of the organic materials that we are composting.

Why is Composting Important?

Food and yard waste make up about 30% of our waste stream. Composting is a great way to reduce our waste, save landfill space, sequester carbon, and reduce greenhouse gas emissions. Finished compost is an excellent soil amendment and a great way to improve your soil. Residents and businesses in municipalities of more than 5,000 people are required by State law to separate leaf waste from other waste. These municipalities must also provide a collection program for the material.

Do I need a Compost Bin?

You can compost with or without a bin. People who want to use a bin can build their own or purchase a commercially available bin. There are plans available online to build a variety of bins.



How do I Compost?

- 1. First, pick a location for your composite pile. It should be convenient for you, partly shaded, dry, and flat. Items to consider when picking a location include your neighbors, water supply, and end use of the finish compost.
- 2. Next add your materials. The ideal ratio is three parts brown materials to one part green material. Green material is higher Nitrogen which feeds the microbes that drive the compost process. See back side for common brown and green materials. You may substitute a small amount of a Nitrogen fertilizer if you don't have green material available. Conversely, you can use sawdust or shredded paper/cardboard if you are short on brown materials.
- 3. Make sure your compost pile has sufficient moisture. It should feel slightly moist. If it is too dry, add water, and if it is too wet, add material.
- 4. Turn (mix) the pile every seven days. Check the moisture content after turning.
- 5. You should have compost in six to seven weeks if you followed the 3:1 recipe, turned it regularly, and maintained the proper moisture content.

WHAT CAN I USE COMPOST FOR?

Finished compost is a great soil amendment that should be mixed in with the top 6 inches of soil. Compost is also a suitable mulch. Compost can be used as a potting mix - more than a quarter to a third of the total potting mix should be compost.

What should I avoid in my Compost Bin?




