

First, to prepare the artichokes for cooking, slice off the stems at the base and cut about 1 inch off of the top. Cut off the points of the leaves with scissors.

Microwave: Arrange two prepared artichokes upside down in a microwave-safe, flat baking dish with 1/2 cup of lightly salted water. Cover. Cook on high for about 8 minutes, or until the base is tender enough to pierce with a fork.

Boil: Fill a large pot with 4 quarts of water, 1 tablespoon salt, and juice from 1 lemon (optional). Bring to a boil and drop in one to four prepared artichokes right side up. Boil uncovered until the base tests tender when pierced with a fork, about 30 minutes. Drain upside down on a cooling rack.

Barbecue: Cut and trim several medium-sized artichokes, then cut in half lengthwise down through the stem. This will expose the choke or furry part. With a paring knife, dig out the choke. Put them in a steamer and cook until the bases are fork-tender, about 25 minutes; add more water as needed. Cool. Marinate with equal parts olive oil, balsamic vinegar, and soy sauce – about 1/3 cup of each for four artichokes. (Add grated fresh garlic, salt and pepper, if you wish.) Refrigerate at least 2 hours.

Barbecue with the cut side down about 5 minutes on each side over medium heat until there is a slightly charred look.



choice in hopes of getting an antlerless life Management Unit (WMU) of your today's day and age with advanced computer technology, why couldn't Pennsvlvania go to a "point of sale system" where you could either purchase your antlerless licenses online or from a license is- won't happen. suing agent (retailer, county treasurer. Game Commission Office)?

be a better way to do antlerless licenses and last year: 2023, they got rid of the pink envelope mail-in system and implemented an automated "point of sale" system. Now, if you are not a deer hunter, you might not remember where you were or what you were doing on Mon., June 26, 2023, but our hunters clearly remember the inefficiency and massive time wasted as they either waited "in the queue" online for hours at a retailer. county courthouse, or Game Commission Office as of thousands of hunters all trying to get their general hunting licenses and first antlerless license at the same time. Some Walmarts around PA had lines snaked throughout the store and out the door as hundreds waited hours to get their chance to buy their licenses. With everyone trying to get into the system online when it became available at exactly 8am, I personally couldn't get in until a few minutes after 8am and my "placeholder" in the queue was above 14.000. It wasn't system almost grind to a halt and the processing speed go down to only a handful per minute, that the system finally gave me my email notice it was my turn to any additional licenses I chose (archery, bear, muzzleloader, etc.), and the highly desired antlerless license I wanted. If you Mon., August 26, 8am - Round 4 opens are hunter, you too remember what you went through last year and like me, you have no desire to repeat that fiasco again.

That gives most PA deer hunters 11-days to either go online or to an issuing agent to purchase their initial antlerless license. The PGC's intent is to avoid a massive rush on their system on June 27 by giving hunters that 11-day "guaranteed window." Now, if you are standing in line or waiting on the line for hours or they physically stood in computer queue for hours on June 27, it's vour own fault because vou could wait a few days and still purchase the same antthe system was overwhelmed by tens lerless license. This includes all of Lawrence County, which is in WMU 1A.

Mon., July 8, 8am - Round 1 opens for Nonresidents on a first come, first served basis for all WMUs which have remaining antlerless licenses. This is when many highly desired WMUs will sell out. If you're a PA resident don't wait, purchase your first antlerless license before July 8 and you'll be good.



And these things we write to you that your joy may be full. 1 John 1:4 Read: 1 John 1:1-2:6

What does reading do for you? The National Geographic magazine informs. A mystery intrigues. A Biography inspires. But no reading is more powerful than reading a letter from someone you love.

Much of my courtship with my wife was carried on with the help of the U.S. Postal Service. While in the army, mail call highlighted my days. I recognized her familiar handwriting on the envelope instantly. The letter's salutation, contents, and closing quickened my heart. They were lines between lovers who found meaning even between the lines.

That's how we should read the Bible. Speaking at a Sunday evening service on this theme. Mart De Haan used the phrase, "heart-to-heart, mind-tomind, will-to-will." He meant that we should look beyond the Bible's familiar words and get to know the heart, mind, and will of its author - God Himself.
