



fall all across the spectrum. At one end. you have folks who have never made the 2.5-hour trip from our area up to the PA Wilds Region to see the PA elk herd for themselves. Then you have the folks **Rebirth of Elk Country**" and is highly who have made the trip once, who can say, "been there, done that." At the center, are the individuals who make periodic pilgrimages up to visit the elk and relish the opportunity to see the majestic animals, hear the bulls bugling, and capture incredible photographs. Then vou have the folks who make the trip several times each year to be close to the elk and often have standing reservations at a campground, cabin, Airbnb, or hotel to be amongst the elk as frequenttheir lives by either purchasing a camp in the area to get there as frequently as their schedules permit, or they have moved to the region to become permanent residents of the PA Wilds Region and relish living amongst the elk.

I personally know individuals who fall all across this spectrum. I admit we fall at the center of the continuum, since at least one dedicated day to visit the PA elk herd each year is required and many years we make more than one trip to the PA Wilds Region for elk viewing. Now, if you fall anywhere on the spectrum, other than those who have never visited the elk, you've probably been to the highly educational Elk Country Visitors Center in Benezette and read the informative signs at Winslow Hill, Hoover's Farm, Dent's Run, and other public elk observation sites to learn something about the PA elk herd. But what if you want to know more? What herd and want "insider" information on what's gone on over the past 150+ years to get the PA elk herd where it is today? What are the significant events, who were the individuals, organizations, and animals to roam freely across a remote portion of "Penn's Woods" today?



If you are heading up to Benezette and the Elk Country Visitor Center this weekend, July 27 & 28, for Elk Expo 2024, you may want to purchase your own copy of "Preserving the Penn-sylvania Wilds: The Rebirth of Elk Country" at the Visitor Center's gift shop or any one of the many other stores in the PA Wilds Region catering to elk viewers. Additionally, Mario's work is widely available online from Google Books, Amazon, and numerous other reputable booksellers. The cover photo of two bull elk battling in the water of Bennett's Branch of Sinnemahoning Creek will definitely catch your eye, if it hasn't already done so during an Elk Country visit within the past 9-months. The book's Forward, written if you are captivated by the PA elk by Rowland Cogan, former PA Game Commission Elk Biologist, in addition to Cofounder and current President and CEO of the Keystone Elk Country Alliance (operators of the Elk Country Visitor Center) will grab your attention and agencies involved, and how did things Mario's prose will definitely keep it for evolve to enable these magnificent all 176-pages. 


