



Who must Recycle: All residents and businesses of New Wilmington are required to recycle at their curb. Property managers must provide recycling for housing, condo, or apartment complexes for situations where they arrange for trash disposal.

How are Materials Collected: At your curb. Materials can be mixed together. Each household has previously been issued a blue 95- gallon recycle tote. The recycle cart should be placed at the curb on Wednesday evening by 10:00 PM. Please leave at least 2 feet between the refuse cart and the recycle cart.

When: The current schedule can be found on the Borough's website. Recycle collection is currently every other week on Thursday.

Spring Cleanup: A spring cleanup is held annually for Borough residential customers. Consult the website or contact the Borough for the schedule.

Large/Bulky Item Pickup: Bulky items are collected throughout the year through special arrangements with Tri-County Industries. Contact the borough office to arrange special pickups.

Leaf & Yard Waste (excluding grass): Consult the schedule on the Borough website. Leaf waste must be placed in a brown paper leaf bag.

Christmas Trees: Christmas trees are collected through January 30th. Trees must be at curb by 7 a.m. on each Monday.

Electronics and Household Hazardous Waste/Chemicals (HHW):

Electronics and HHW are collected curbside by appointment. Schedule an appointment by:



Only bottles, jugs, cans, and clean paper are recyclable in the curbside program. Do not place materials in plastic bags and do not include any items not listed. Acceptable materials may periodically change so always follow the information provided from your hauler. Businesses must also recycle but may pick the recycling hauler of their choice.

USEFUL INFORMATION:

Recycling can be confusing because what is accepted as recyclable may be different between hauling companies and communities. Recycling programs are driven by markets and vary from region to region and state to state. Newer residents that move to our community are often surprised by the differences.

"Wishcycling" and Contamination

Contamination occurs when trash/unacceptable materials are placed in your recycling bin. With wishcycling people mean well, but unintentionally hurt recycling programs by placing the wrong materials into their bins. Examples include plastic toys, food containers, tubing, or buckets. When placed in the recycling bin, these and similar items must be physically removed and then landfilled. It is estimated that up to 20% of the cost of recycling is used to deal with items that should have been placed in the trash. Items that are not listed as recyclable WILL NOT get recycled. This includes plastic bags.

Plastic is the most confusing material because it comes in a variety of forms and resins that are chemically different. People often think that because something is "plastic" that it is recyclable. This is not the case. The same holds true with the "recycling" symbol and number commonly found on plastic items. The purpose of the symbol and number is to indicate the resin type. It has nothing to do with recycling!

Instead, focus on the shape of item. When it comes to recycling, think "plastic bottles/jugs, metal cans, and clean paper." If you're holding a plastic item, consider if it is a bottle. For example, butter tubs, yogurt containers, and clam-shell/take-out food containers are plastic and usually have a recycling symbol and number on them. But—they are not a bottle/jug and belong in the trash. When in doubt, throw it out.

How to Prepare Your Recyclables

A simple rinse of food/beverage bottles and jugs is all that is needed. Cardboard should be flattened and mixed papers (magazines, junk mail, newspapers) can be placed in your bin loosely or in a brown paper bag. Do not put any materials in plastic bags. Plastic bags must be ripped open. And loose bags jam conveyor belts and gears. They are a significant cost to manage when they get into the system and will not get recycled at the recycling center. Many local grocers accept plastic bags for recycling.

by Sam Mazzotta DEAR PAW'S CORNER: I'm 16 and love pets – I have a dog, cat and an iguana already -- and I want to start my own pet sitting business. What is the best way to start? How do I get customers? Do I need a license or something? - Jeannie H., Pittsburgh DÉAR JEANNIE: Pet sitting can be a great business to get into. Every pet owner needs someone to watch their pet from time to time: long workdays, vacations, illness and so on. However, it's a business that carries a lot of responsibility. Being reliable is very important and is essential to building your reputation as a sitter that pet owners can trust. I recommend a

I recommend a trial period first, with a couple of neighbors or your parents' friends. This will give you an idea of what the job entails, how long it takes to care for each pet, and can open your eyes to opportunities. For example, a neighbor who works from home may not need a sitter, but their dog could use an extra walk in the afternoon.

At the same time, study up on the requirements for running a business. Entrepreneurship courses are often available for free through your local library or at the Small Business Association (where you can also find a business mentor).

Most states don't have a licensing requirement for pet sitters, but you can get a certification through Pet Sitters International (petsit.com), or the National Association of Professional Pet Sitters (petsitters.org). These organizations offer a wealth of information – including how to find clients.
