

PROPER RECYCLING CURBSIDE RECYCLING LAWRENCE COUNTY

A Guide to doing it right in Lawrence and Mercer Counties

What is "Curbside Recycling?"

Curbside recycling is simply having recyclables picked up at your home. It does not mean that a physical "curb" is required.

Am I Required to Recycle Curbside?

All residents and businesses of the following municipalities are required by state and local laws to recycle curbside: *City of New Castle, Ellwood City Borough, Neshannock Township, Shenango Township, and Union Township.*

These are called "Mandated Municipalities." Residents and businesses in New Wilmington Borough are required to recycle curbside by local laws. Residents and businesses of all other Lawrence County municipalities are not required to recycle curbside, but are encouraged to do so voluntarily. See "I live in a Municipality where I am not required to Recycle Curbside, but I would like to do so. What options do I have for curbside recycling?" for more information.

What Can I Recycle?

Most curbside recycling programs in Lawrence County collect recyclables via "single stream" recycling. Single stream recycling is designed to make recycling as easy as possible for residents. All of the materials listed below can be mixed together in the same container. There is no need to separate them. The following materials are usually included in single stream recycling programs:

- #1, #2, and sometimes #5 Plastic Bottles & Jugs
- Aluminum Cans
- Steel/Tin Cans
- Magazines
- Corrugated Cardboard
- Newspaper
- Paperboard (cereal boxes, etc.)
- Junk Mail

If it is not on the list - it belongs in the trash. When in doubt, throw it out or recycle it elsewhere. Acceptable materials may differ between haulers. Be sure to follow the guidelines provided by your hauler!

What are the advantages of curbside recycling over a drop-off recycling program?

Curbside Recycling is:

EASY - All materials can be mixed together in the same container.

CONVENIENT - You can do it at your own home without making a special trip to a recycling site.

ENVIRONMENTALLY FRIENDLY - No more using your gas to go to a recycling site. We estimate that 400,000 cars use the county recycling drop-off sites annually consuming about 48,000 gallons of fuel in the process.

I live in a municipality where I am not required to recycle curbside, but I would like to do so. What options do I have for curbside recycling?

Effective October 9, 2014, all haulers providing regular trash collection services are required to provide recycling services to residents that request it but do not live in a Mandated Municipality. This requirement is for haulers only. Residents are not required to request the service and may decline it if offered. There may be additional fees for recycling. To summarize: if you want to recycle curbside at your home, your hauler must provide you with the service.

What kind of recycling bin can I use for curbside recycling?

Recycling bins vary. Some haulers and municipalities will provide you with a container. You can also purchase your own container through a local hardware or department store. Wheeled containers and carts are easy to move and provide adequate room for all your recyclables. Additionally, wheeled carts have lids that prevent litter and keep recyclables dry. Traditional bins may be used as well but are prone to accidental littering in windy conditions.

What about Plastic Bags, Toys, Windows, etc.?

These items do not belong in your recycling bin. Plain and simple. Plastic bags can be recycled at some local stores. Items such as plastic toys, chairs, and food containers and glass windows, ceramics, and Pyrex all go into your trash. If it is not a bottle, jug, can, jar or clean piece of paper, it does not belong in your bin.

Including items not listed for recycling contaminates your recyclables and significantly increases the cost because all contaminates must be removed before the material can be recycled.

What about Leaves?

All Mandated Municipalities, including New Wilmington, offer leaf waste collection. Contact your municipality for details.

What about Electronics, Paint, Chemicals, Fluorescent Lights, Tires, etc.?

Local options do exist for these items. Check out the Lawrence-Mercer Recycling Solid Waste Department website, www.co.lawrence.pa.us/ recycling for information about these materials. Click the "Calendar of Events" link for a listing of planned events that serve our area.

Outdoor Opportunities By COL (Ret.) Grey D. Berrier II Fishermen Aren't the Only Ones Out There **Pursuing Trout in PÅ Waterways** The

March to the many streams, creeks, rivers, lakes, and reservoirs selected to hold trout. It is by design these fish are put into the various waterways several weeks before trout season opens, so they have the opportunity to become acclimated to their new watery homes. This includes spreading out to find suitable cover and feeding stations as they learn to become "independent," which includes sustaining themselves on various forms of insect life and other potential food sources, instead of the steady diet of fish pellets they grew up on in a fish hatchery.

Saturday, March 29, 2025, is our PA Mentored Youth Trout Day. This special one-day season is designed to allow youth anglers under 16 the first opportunity to fish stocked trout waters, when trout are most abundant. To participate, youths must possess either a Mentored Youth Permit or Voluntary Youth Fishing License and be accompanied by a licensed adult. The following Saturday, April 5, is the Opening Day of PA's Statewide Trout Season and starting at 8 AM determined anglers will be plying the waters with a wide variety of baits, lures, and flies to entice trout to bite. It is always interesting how some recently stocked trout are easy to catch and others released at the same time can be challenging.

What you may not know is that even before March 29 or April 5, our recently stocked PA trout have been under coninitially released into the water from the stocking trucks. I'm not talking about the unscrupulous few, the "fish poachers," who have been fishing illegally in stocked trout waters prior to the legal start of the season and hoping they don't get apprehended by a Waterways Conservation Officer (WCO) or one of some other fish who are opportunistic and won't shy away from a trout dinner.

Now, I don't want to be guilty of causing distracted driving, but have you ever noticed when you are traveling on I-376, just below the Mitchell Road Exit, when you look to the West about 55" sign in the eastbound lane, there are a significant number of large nests in the massive sycamore trees roughly 400 yards away. If you look closely,



I can't tell you how many times I've been fishing a small stream or creek for trout stealthily working my way upstream and I'll come around a bend to find a Great Blue Heron standing statuesque, just waiting to grab an unsuspecting trout. Often times you will find their large footprints (which appear much like a wild turkey's) in the streamside sand or mud, or visible underwater in the soft bottom, and also large white patches where they defecated after consuming a meal. Sometimes you will encounter them sitting on an overhead branch just watching for their next prey. Great Blue Herons will either grab trout or spear with them with their bills before swallowing them whole. I remember a PSU fisheries professor telling us a Great Blue Heron can digest an entire 14-inch trout in 12-hours. If each of those Great Blue Herons from our local colony were to take a trout a day from local waters, the toll would quickly add up.

Standing roughly 3.5-feet tall, with a massive almost 6-foot wingspan, Great Blue Herons seem to be in regular flight paralleling the Shenango River with their legs straight back and necks curled in an "S." They slowly flap their wings and occasionally make a croaking sound as they head out in the morning and return to their colony in the evening. I've also seen them many times flying overhead at Giant Eagle on Wilmstant predation ever since they were ington Road as they head to or from Neshannock Creek. Great Blue Herons are a primary reason why fish hatcheries require protective netting to avoid predation on the valuable fish they are raising.

Besides Great Blue Herons, other birds that may take an occasional trout include bald eagles, ospreys, and cormorants. When it comes to mammalian their Deputies. Rather, I'm talking about predators, the likely suspects include a variety of birds, mammals, and even otters and mink, with possibly an opportunistic raccoon, beaver, black bear, or bobcat taking a trout here or there. Then there are the Alpha predators of the waterways, like muskellunge and flathead catfish, that won't hesitate to consume any trout they may encounter. The trout you are after also has many other predathe moment you pass the "Speed Limit tors pursuing it! Trout soon learn to be "the quick" or they'll be "the dead!"


