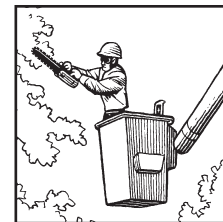

## Outdoor Opportunities

### Often Overlooked, Freshwater Mussels are Vital for Healthy PA Waters (Part 1 of 2)

I have to admit, I recently had one of those “the more you know, the more you realize you don’t know” moments, when it comes to the diverse flora and fauna inhabiting PA’s waterways. On Fri., May 16, I had the privilege of visiting the PA Fish & Boat Commission’s Union City Aquatic Conservation Center (UC ACC) during the PA Outdoor Writers Association Conference in Erie. Accompanied by three other conference attendees, we didn’t really know what we were going to see, learn, and experience when we signed up for the tour. Initially opened in 1905 as a warm-water species Fish Hatchery, the PFBC began in 2017 to convert the main concrete building built in 1927 to focus on freshwater mussel propagation.

After constructing extensive recirculating systems, Union City received their first freshwater mussels in Aug. 2019 to work with and in May 2020 began raising freshwater mussels from start-to-finish. Renamed the Aquatic Conservation Center in Aug. 2022, their efforts concentrate solely on the conservation of PA non-game animals, which includes freshwater mussels, non-game fishes, turtles, snakes, and amphibians. The driving force behind the UC ACC is PFBC Species Recovery Biologist, Scott Ray, whose formal education and practical aquarium experience, make him the ideal proponent for the often overlooked and frequently unknown freshwater mussels. During our three-hour tour, which included the main concrete building, an adjacent quarantine garage, and the near-by propagation pond, we were enthralled by Scott’s extensive knowledge and experience as we learned about the freshwater mussels inhabiting our waters.

PA is home to over 60 freshwater mussel species, some of which are thriving, while others are of state-concern, and a few have reached federal-concern over their diminished numbers. Unfortunately, even freshwater mussels have to compete with invasive species, such as the Zebra mussel, which arrived in the Great Lakes via the ballast tanks of large ocean-going ships coming from the Black and Caspian Seas of Eastern Europe. There is great concern over Zebra Mussels expanding into other PA waterways from Lake Erie and why the PFBC has ongoing efforts to educate fisherman and boaters on the importance of properly cleaning their equipment and boats to avoid unwanted “hitchhikers.”

We were shown their extensive array of propagation and quarantine tanks throughout the facility for all stages of mussel growth and development, along with the surprising, very specific “host fish-species,” some mussels require. Their encompassing display revealed the vast differences in size, shape, coloration, and texture between species. Additionally, their colorful names did not go unnoticed, such as Elktote, Elephant Ear, Pocket-book, White Heelsplitter, Rough Pigtoe, and Spike.

Freshwater mussels are bivalve mollusks, having two-part shells held together by a hinge comprised of ligaments and adductor muscles. However, while their top and bottom shells are symmetrical, they differ from clams in that a mussel’s top or bottom shell does not have symmetry between their right and left halves. An interesting fact I learned about freshwater mussels is that while I had a preconceived notion they were like barnacles and were stuck in one place for their entire existence, mussels (like clams) can actually use their foot (an appendage that extends outside their shell) to move themselves across a stream, river, or lake bed. While it may not seem like much, they can move up to 10-feet in a day, which may coincide with the rise or fall of the water-level and keep them submerged. Another fact that surprised me is that while many freshwater mussels have a life-span of 10 to 15-years, some can live for 50 to 75-years, and the Eastern Pearlshell has been known to live up to 100-years old. How do they know how old a freshwater mussel is? Remarkably, their shells have annual growth rings and can be aged by them.

Now you may think, why do freshwater mussels matter? While they are existing partially buried in a waterways’ bed, they are constantly filter-feeding. Each adult mussel filters 8 to 10-gallons of water per day to feed upon algae, bacteria, plankton, and detritus (decaying organic matter). The thousands of mussels in any waterway constantly filter the water and help remove impurities and turbidity. Biologists have learned freshwater mussels are a waterway’s “canaries in a coalmine” and their presence or absence, and their health/population density are excellent indicators of a waterway’s overall condition. Research has shown past environmental contamination events can be traced by the chemicals/compounds in the annual shell growth rings of freshwater mussels. Next week, we’ll explore the fascinating, yet little-known, reproductive behavior of our PA freshwater mussels!

DEAR PAW'S CORNER: This close to Memorial Day, I hope you can call attention to the sacrifices made by war dogs, who have served side by side with American troops for over 100 years, taking on missions that their human counterparts could never do so well. Many gave their lives protecting others. - Charles B., via email

DEAR CHARLES: Absolutely. Military working dogs, often called "war dogs," are an essential part of America's armed forces. They provide security around the world and are trained for specialized missions like drugs and explosives detection, sentry duty, scouting, and search and rescue. Military working dogs are even part of special forces units. Over the past century, war dogs have played essential roles.

In the past, German Shepherds were the primary breed used as military working dogs. Recently, the armed services have shifted to slightly smaller breeds. The Belgian Malinois is the preferred breed for military working dogs today.

Sadly, during the Vietnam War, thousands of military working dogs overseas were euthanized or abandoned when their service was done. In 2000, President Clinton signed a law that allowed war dogs to be adopted once their service was over.

More than 400 military working dogs have been killed in action since World War II. It's estimated that they have saved over 10,000 lives. Today, a War Dog memorial stands in Bristol Township, Pennsylvania, to call attention to these selfless heroes, as well as a War Dog statue outside the Airborne & Special Operations Museum in Fayetteville, North Carolina.

As we remember the sacrifices of American troops, I hope you'll all take a moment to remember the loyal, highly trained working dogs who gave their all to keep their comrades in arms safe from harm.

**American Glassware**

With the invention of the mechanical glass press in the 1800s, the glassmaking industry moved away from free-blown, hand-decorated pieces and embraced new ways to mass-produce inexpensive decorative glass. But not everyone wanted to leave the old ways behind.

Brothers Henry Thomas, Lorenzo, and William Elbert Clevenger were apprentices at the Moore Brothers Clayton Glass Works, where their father, William Henry, also worked. The Clayton Glass Works closed in 1912. In 1930, the Clevenger brothers constructed their own glass furnace in their backyard in Clayton, New Jersey. They used their training to make glass in the old-fashioned South Jersey style developed in the colonial years: free-blown vessels decorated with blobs or threads of glass applied by hand. They soon started making mold-blown glass, including reproductions of famous antique bottles like the Fislerville Jenny Lind calabash flask and the figural E.G. Booz whiskey bottle.

A Clevenger Brothers vase sold for \$192 at an auction by Jeffrey S. Evans. It was free-blown, with a rough pontil mark as evidence. Its two handles, decorative glass blobs called lily pads, and the threading around its neck were applied by hand. The vase's medium blue color is also faithful to the earlier glass traditions. It is still recognizable as a 20th-century piece; for one thing, Clevenger Brothers glass is usually heavier than pieces made in the 1700s and 1800s. The brothers' intent was not to create forgeries of valuable antique glassware but to continue the traditions of their glassmaking forebears.

**TIP:**  
Never put silverware and stainless-steel flatware in the dishwasher basket together. The stainless can damage the silver.

## How To Make Mental Health Matter

Mental health is now discussed more openly than it once was. Mental illness or issues that affected mental health used to be stigmatized, and many people suffered in silence and might not have gotten the help they needed.

The National Institute of Mental Health reports more than one in five adults in the United States

lives with a mental illness. Mental illnesses include many different conditions that may vary in degree of severity, from very mild to severe. The Centre for Addiction and Mental Health advises that, in any given year, one in five Canadians experiences a mental illness as well. Such statistics highlight just how common mental illnesses are.

The NIMH notes self-care plays a significant role in maintaining mental health and supporting recovery. People can safeguard their mental health in many ways, and doing so will improve their overall health as well.

- Spend time in nature. Nature can have a calming effect on people. Going for a walk can help tame stress and break patterns of negative thinking. In Japan, the concept of forest bathing is said to improve mental health. Forest bathing involves spending time in a forest or another green area experiencing the different sounds, sights and smells that nature offers.

- Set boundaries. B2B Reviews says 12 percent of U.S. workers were fully remote in August 2023. Estimates suggest that number may have increased to around 14 percent by 2025. Working from home can make it more challenging to set firm divisions on time spent working and for home life. Establishing boundaries means not being available 24/7 for calls or emails and not feeling guilty about taking time away from work.

- Get regular exercise. Just 30 minutes of exercise each day can get feel-good endorphins flowing through the body to boost mood and bodily health.

- Get more sleep. Adults generally need between seven and nine hours of sleep for optimal health and reaching deep sleep phases, says the Mental Health Foundation. Creating consistent sleep routines that include going to bed and waking at the same time each day; avoiding screens before bed; and avoiding caffeine or vigorous exercise late in the day can help improve sleep.

- Try relaxing activities. Relaxing activities can include reading, listening to music, meditation, or low-stress crafts and hobbies. Make time each week for these calming pursuits.

- Socialize with others. Socialization provides opportunities to see others and talk about anything you want to get off your chest. People feeling stress or anxiety might think they are alone. But having conversations with others can illustrate that these are common problems and there are solutions. Sometimes just talking about an issue can help you overcome it.

- Use your vacation time. Too many people are not using enough of their deserved and accrued time off. A survey from the financial services company Sorbet found that 62 percent of Americans don't use all of their paid time off. A Pew Research Center survey found that nearly half of U.S. employees with paid time off take less time than their employers offer. Failure to take time off is a recipe for burnout. Mental health should be a priority.

Safeguarding mental health can involve various self-care techniques that anyone can employ.

## BEST BITES



### Soup Up Summer With Easy Two-Tone Garden Variety Dishes

"The best tasting soups of summer are the simplest to make," said chef Becca Berroteran to a group of moms at Mission Springs Camps and Conference Center in Scotts Valley, California. "And each bowlful can look like a work of art, too," she added.

We watched attentively as she ladled red pepper soup into one side of a soup bowl, while at the same time ladling a fresh zucchini soup in the other. The soups are a nod to her Mexican heritage.

"Busy families can make a two-toned garden soup in less than an hour on the stove or microwave," she said as she grabbed a squeeze bottle to demonstrate the garnish. "Kids love to top the servings with cream sauce designs and swirls, or you can let them simply add popcorn or crunched chips."

Here are the basic how-tos. Add your favorite fresh herbs and seasonings to make the soup your own, then have fun impressing your next dinner guests:

#### TWO-TONED GARDEN SOUP

Ingredients for zucchini soup:

- 3 medium zucchini, roughly chopped
- 2 cups chicken broth
- 1/2 cup chopped yellow onion
- 1/2 tablespoon chopped fresh garlic
- Salt and pepper

Bring the zucchini, broth, onions, garlic and seasonings to a boil, stirring frequently. Simmer until zucchini is soft, about 20 minutes. Use immersion hand blender to blend.

Ingredients for the roasted red pepper soup:

- 2 (12-ounce) jars fire roasted red peppers, drained
- 2 cups beef broth
- Hot sauce (optional)

Cook peppers and beef stock until heated through. Use immersion hand blender to blend. Ladle hot soups simultaneously into each half of a soup bowl, then "paint" designs with avocado cream sauce.

#### AVOCADO CREAM SAUCE

Stir together 1/4 mashed ripe avocado, 2 tablespoons sour cream, 1/8 teaspoon cumin, and a splash of milk to make it "squeezeable." Spoon into a squeeze bottle and create these easy designs on top of the two-tone soup. Makes 8-10 servings.

#### HEARTS

Squeeze out several dime-sized dots. Dip into the middle of a dot with a chopstick or skewer and drag down to form a heart. Continue to the next dot.

#### STARBURST

Squeeze a quarter-sized dot in the center of the soup. Dip a toothpick in the center and lightly drag it out to make a line. Repeat in all directions.

#### ABC's

Squeeze the shape of the first letter of the names of each guest on the soup. Set the bowls around the table when you are ready to eat for edible place cards!

Cook's Tip: Prepared ranch dressing is a quick substitute for the avocado cream sauce.

### DID YOU KNOW?

July 4, 1776, is an important date in American history that is widely considered the birthday of the United States of America. But some people argue that August 2 should actually be America's birthday, since that was when the Declaration of Independence was signed. The National Archives says that the Second Continental Congress adopted the United States Declaration of independence on July 4, 1776, formally severing ties with Britain. The approved Declaration was printed on July 5. On July 19, Congress ordered that the document be engrossed on parchment, which is a process of copying an official document in large hand. It is surmised that the engrosser was Timothy Matlock, an assistant to Charles Thomson, secretary to the

Congress. It was nearly a month after the Declaration was adopted before the document began to be signed by delegates. The signing of the Declaration of Independence occurred primarily on August 2, 1776, at the Pennsylvania State House in Philadelphia, a building later renamed Independence Hall. John Hancock, who was the President of the Congress, was the first to sign the engrossed copy. Signatures were arranged by states from northernmost to southernmost. Fifty-six delegates eventually signed the document, although not all were present to sign on August 2. Some delegates never managed to sign the Declaration, including Robert R. Livingston of New York, who was a member of the Declaration's drafting committee.

# PROPER RECYCLING PLASTIC BAGS & FILM

## A Guide to doing it right in Lawrence and Mercer Counties

Plastic bags are a popular choice for transporting goods from the point of purchase to our homes. Film plastic is commonly used by manufactures for packaging because it is less costly and lightweight compared to other materials such as cardboard. Most plastic bags that arise from grocery and department store purchases are recyclable.

### What Types of Plastic Bags and Film Can I Recycle?

There is a long list of film plastics that can be recycled with plastic bags. It includes the following.

Newspaper bags	Dry Cleaning Bags	Product Wraps	Veggie Bags
Bread Bags	Furniture Wrap	Electronic Wrap	Bubble Wrap

### What Problems Do Plastic Bags Cause in Regular Curbside and Drop-off Recycling Programs?

Plastic bags do not belong in curbside and drop-off recycling programs. Materials from these programs are sent to recycling centers that are not equipped to process plastic bags and film. Plastic bags containing recyclables that arrive at recycling centers must be physically opened to remove their contents. Loose bags wrap around cogs, conveyers, and equipment resulting in facility shutdowns. The manual labor used to open and remove plastic bags and shutdowns is extremely costly to recycling operations. Plastic bags that end up at local traditional recycling centers will not get recycled.

Plastic bags also contribute to litter and microplastic pollution because they are easily carried by wind and water.

Plastic bags are recyclable but they must be taken to designated locations. Do not put plastic bags or film into your curbside recycling bins or the county big blue bins.

### Plastic Bag Alternatives

Bring reusable cloth bags with you when you go shopping. Reusable bags can be washed and used many times. They are also available in a variety of sizes.

Paper bags may be a good option if you don't have reusable cloth bags. Paper bags can be recycled in some curbside and drop-off programs. Remember to check with your program guidelines first.

There are also reusable veggie, sandwich, and other specialty bags available that can be used in place of traditional plastic bags.

Reuse your plastic bags around the home whenever possible.
