

## **Outdoor Opportunities** By COL (Ret.) Grey D. Berrier II PA 2025-26 Hunting Licenses Go On Sale June 23 & There Are Changes (Part 1 of 2)

You know you are a PA outdoorsman or woman IF...you know what constitutes a year. Now that statement may seem odd to someone who doesn't

fish or hunt, but the answer is: It depends. Here in the Commonwealth, fishing licenses are pretty straightforward and are sold on a calendar basis. So, if you purchased a 2025 one-year license, it is valid from Jan. 1, 2025 thru Dec. 31, 2025. That makes sense. However, PA hunting licenses coincide with our State Fiscal Year, which runs from July 1 of one year until June 30 of the next year. So, your 2024-25 PA hunting license that you purchased last year is getting ready to expire on June 30, 2025. Which means new PA 2025-26 hunting licenses, which will be good from July 1, 2025 thru June 30, 2026 are getting ready to go on sale starting Monday, June 23, 2025.

With new hunting licenses come some changes in rules, regulations, seasons, and bag limits each year; and 2025-26 is no different. So, we're going to cover those changes to make sure you are aware of them and how they may impact your upcoming hunting plans. This will be our third year of "over the counter" antlerless deer license sales. The "pink envelope lottery" of mailing to the county treasurer of your choice to get your doe license(s) is dead and gone. Two years ago, the first year of "over the counter" antlerless sales was marked by extremely long lines at license vendors, excessive waits for online purchases, and a computerized sales system that nearly ground to a halt based on the high volume of sales. Last year, things got much better as the PA Game Commission (PGC) tried to spread out sales over a several week time period by guaranteeing antlerless licenses to PA Residents in all but three highly sought after Wildlife Management Units (WMUs), which included 1B, 2G, and 3A. Well, the big change for 2025-26 is the PGC is guaranteeing a PA antlerless license to all PA Residents in the WMU of their choice, if they purchase their initial antlerless license anytime between 8 AM, Mon., June 23 and 7 AM, Mon., July 14.

Last year's antlerless license sales revealed that WMUs 1B and 3A did not sell out during the initial first round open only to PA Residents and while WMU 2G did, the antlerless license allocation for WMU 2G has been increased from 37,000 up to 57,000 (+20,000 tags) for 2025-26, so that is

why they are able to make this "guaranteed antlerless tag offer." Think about that for a moment, since it has never happened before in PA hunting history. If you are a PA Resident, you can get your first antlerless license in any WMU of your choice, if you pur-

chase your initial antlerless license anytime between 8 ÅM, Mon., June 23 and 7 AM, Mon., July 14. No need to go stand in line on June 23 starting at 6 AM at Walmart, the County Treasurer's Office, or your favorite outdoor retailer to get there before "the next guy," unless you simply like standing in line for absolutely no reason. You basically now have a three week (21-day) window in which you can purchase your first PA antlerless license in the WMU of your choice, either in person at a license vendor or online, completely stress-free. However, "if you snooze, you lose," because starting at 8 AM on Monday, July 14, when antlerless licenses initially go on sale to Nonresidents, all remaining antlerless licenses in every WMU are sold on a "first come, first served" basis until exhausted.

To summarize important PA 2025-26 antlerless license sales dates: (1) June 23 - 1st round opens at 8AM for PA Residents with guaranteed WMU of their choice; (2) July 14 - 1st Round opens at 8 AM for Nonresidents. Resident procrastinators can still purchase their first license, but no guarantee on WMU availability. In 1st Round personal limit is one license for Residents and Nonresidents; (3) July 28 - 2nd Round opens for All License Buyers. Personal limit is two antlerless licenses; (4) August 11 – 3rd Round opens for All License Buyers. Personal limit is three antlerless licenses; and (5) August 25 - 4th Round opens for All License Buyers. Personal limit is six antlerless licenses. While it may only interest a few hunters from our area, WMUs 5C and 5D in the extreme Southeastern Corner (think Philadelphia and surrounding counties) have a new limit of 15 antlerless licenses as of the 4th Round to promote antlerless harvests in those heavily populated areas with limited deer habitat and frequent deer-vehicle collisions.

Overall, the antlerless license allocation across PA's 22 WMUs increased by 10.6% from 1,186,000 to 1,312,000 with 12 WMUs increasing, 5 WMUs remaining the same (our local WMU 1A stayed at 46,000), and 5 WMUs surprisingly decreased some to reflect the PGC's desired harvest numbers. Keep in mind, statistically one out of four antlerless licenses sold is successfully filled. Next week, we'll cover DMAP, Ag Tags, and changes to some seasons & bag limits.

DEAR PAW'S CORNER: I moved from a suburb to the mountains a couple of months ago, and while my dogs are thrilled to have several acres to run free on. I'm terrified that they will be bitten by rattlesnakes. A

neighbor said that they are plentiful out here. How can I prevent this, and what do I do if they get bitten? - Larry in Tennessee

DEAR LARRY: While there is always a risk of a dog getting injured by something out in the countryside, it's important not to let fear get the best of you. Instead, focus on prevention. Here are some of the things you can do to minimize their overall risk of injury - from snakes and other potential risks.

- Train your dogs to come when you call them; if your property is big enough that they run out of sight, train them to respond to a whistle, which carries much farther.

- Rattlesnakes (and other snakes) hang out in messy debris piles, wood stacks and crevices with overhangs. They stay out of sight (they're much more afraid of you and your dogs) unless they are threatened. Clear debris piles off of your property, and stack your firewood on a raised platform, at least 5 feet from your home's foundation.

- If your dogs consistently run to one location on your property, follow them and find out what's so interesting. An animal lair or deer run can be very interesting to dogs, but the same location can attract bigger predators.

- Consider fencing in a half-acre or acre behind your house and keep your dogs within the fence; you'll be able to monitor them better and control the space, so critters don't come in. ©2025 King Features Synd., Inc


