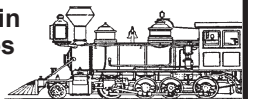

Features to Accommodate Outdoor Cooking

Various things come to mind when pondering outdoor entertaining. Outdoor living spaces run the gamut from expansive oases with a pool, hot tub and room to lounge to smaller areas with some seating that allows hosts and guests to enjoy some fresh air. One common theme in most outdoor living spaces, regardless of their size, is an area to cook, typically over an open flame.

Grilling is wildly popular. According to the grilling experts at Traeger, roughly 128 million households across the United States owned a grill in 2020. Grills are similarly popular in Canada, where a 2023 poll from Ipsos-Reid found that 78 percent of Canadians own a grill. Outdoor cooking is a staple of life in the U.S. and Canada, and this popular means to meal preparation can be made even more enjoyable with a few simple upgrades to an outdoor living space.

• **Natural gas grill:** Natural gas grills are designed to be connected with a home's natural gas line. That can make it more convenient to grill, particularly for people who grill often and do not want to deal with charcoal and propane tanks that require routine trips to a grocery store or other retailer to resupply. With a natural gas grill, cooks can fire up the grill at any time just like they would when using a gas stove indoors.

• **Refrigerator:** Incorporating a refrigerator into an outdoor living space can make outdoor cooking more convenient. Depending on the size of the appliance, an outdoor refrigerator can store condiments and sauces, saving cooks the trouble of walking back and forth between indoor and outdoor living spaces

to gather supplies for cooking. A slightly larger outdoor refrigerator also can be used to store the food that will be cooked on the grill, affording cooks more time to spend outdoors.

• **Outdoor pantry:** An outdoor living space that incorporates a pantry to store dishes and tools of the barbecuing trade, like spatulas and tongs, can make grill sessions easier for cooks. When planning a new outdoor living space, a pantry can be incorporated into the design. If augmenting an existing space, standalone pantries can provide similar functionality as built-in alternatives.

• **Outdoor sink:** All those utensils and cooking instruments will ultimately need to be washed. An outdoor sink ensures utensils and tools can be washed and dried outside, saving hosts the trouble of carrying items in at the end of the night only to return them to the outdoor pantry the following morning. An outdoor sink also makes it easier to rinse vegetables before cooking them over an open flame.

• **Garden bar:** Grilling can be a rewarding but lonely undertaking. Grills often are set away from outdoor dining tables so guests can comfortably converse and eat without being drowned out by the sizzle of the grill or overwhelmed by smoke that can come pouring out when opening the grill lid. A garden bar that's adjacent to the grill can provide a gathering space for guests and ensure cooks aren't spending the duration of a get-together going it alone.

Outdoor cooking is wildly popular, and might prove even more so when incorporating various convenient features into an exterior living space.

Outdoor Opportunities

Hunters Sharing the Harvest is Generosity in Action

When you watch the news on TV, read it in a newspaper/magazine or from your online news feed, or hear it on the radio or a podcast, do you do that simply for entertainment or are you looking for actionable information? In other words, do you desire to find out what's going on, determine "How does this affect me?", and decide "What, if anything, can I do about it?" Maybe, it's just how I'm wired because my personal "news cycle" involves taking it in, analyzing it, and then deciding how I should respond.

Let me give you an example. Recently, it's been in the news about potential substantial funding-cuts and changes in enrollment criteria to the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program. SNAP is the federally-funded program, formerly known as the Food Stamp Program that provides food-purchasing assistance for low-income and no-income persons to help them maintain adequate nutrition and health. Additionally, whether you hear it in the news or see it for yourself, there is a significant portion of our population here in Pennsylvania who are "food insecure." In other words, the reality is they may not know where their next meal is coming from or when it will be. The percentage in PA of individuals who often rely on food banks, food pantries, or a shelter for their sustenance is staggering. It is 1/6 of PA's population, literally 2-million people, which includes over 800,000 children. Those are our "Neighbors in Need" and it breaks my heart, but what can you or me, as individuals, help do about this challenge?

Recently, one of our Associate Pastors preached a sermon about generosity. He pointed out generosity includes giving of our time, our talents, and our resources. OK. How do I personally respond to the food insecurity issue to help those in our local community? Allow me to share one means, which you may not have considered. Pennsylvania is blessed to have Hunters Sharing the Harvest (HSH). HSH is the largest venison donation program in the United States, which last year (2024) netted 281,000 lbs. of fresh ground venison. At an average of 50 lbs. of ground venison per deer, that's roughly 5,620 deer donated to the program, which translated into 1,124,000 quarter-pound servings of high quality protein for those in need. Having attended HSH annual "Kick-Off" events in recent years, I've heard the directors, managers, and volunteer workers from our local food banks and pantries talk about

how high-quality protein sources are their biggest expense and something they often can't afford. Hunter donated venison helps fills that void.

Why am I talking about HSH right now? Because Round 2 of PA antlerless deer licenses opens on Monday, July 28. If you've purchased your PA 2025-26 hunting license, you received your buck tag with it, and there is a good chance you've also purchased your first doe tag by now, since Round 1 of antlerless tags went on sale June 23 to residents and July 14 to nonresidents. If you already have your buck tag and one doe tag, you may be thinking, "I don't need any more deer tags because it's just me, or we're empty nesters and it's only the two of us now." This is where I want you to think about our "Neighbors in Need" and using your time, talents, and resources to harvest additional deer with the intent of donating them to HSH to help feed those facing food insecurity. It's a Win-Win in my book if you get to do more of what you love (hunting deer) and at the same time help others. So, when Round 2 opens on July 28 buy an additional doe tag, then when Round 3 opens on Monday, August 11, and Deer Management Assistance Program (DMAP) tags also go on sale, please consider purchasing additional antlerless tags. Finally, when Round 4 opens on Monday, August 25, and the personal limit on antlerless licenses increases to six, give it some thought, if you are a proficient deer hunter and the idea of children going hungry drives you to want to be part of the solution. In addition to DMAP tags to help balance the deer population on a specific property, there are now "Ag Tags" for farmers suffering significant crop damage. See Page 30 of the PA Hunting & Trapping Digest for more details on "Ag Tags," which used to be called "Red Tags."

There are over 100 participating HSH deer processors spread across the Commonwealth, so there is probably one close to where you live, hunt, or have your camp. We are fortunate to have three here in Lawrence County: Doug Pfeffer's Deer Processing, Ellwood City, a participant since HSH's start in 1991 (724-758-4976); Beatty's Market, Enon Valley, (724-667-6501), and Nashua Livestock, Pulaski, (724-714-5481). READ Psalm 119:159-168

The beautiful bride, gripping her proud father's arm, was poised to make her way to the altar. But not before the entrance of her thirteen-month-old nephew. Instead of carrying the more common "ring"—he was the "Bible bearer." In this way, the bride and groom, as committed believers in Jesus, wanted to testify to their love for Scripture. With minimal distraction, the toddler found his way to the front of the church. How illustrative it was that the toddler's teeth marks were found on the leather cover of the Bible. What a picture of activity that's fitting for believers in Christ or those who desire to know Him—to taste and take in Scripture.

Psalm 119 celebrates the comprehensive worth of the Scriptures. After declaring the blessedness of those who live by God's law (v. 1), the author poetically raved about it, including his love for it. "See how I love your precepts" (v. 159); "I hate and detest falsehood but I love your law" (v. 163); "I obey your statutes, for I love them greatly" (v. 167).

What statements do we make about our love for God and His Word through how we live? One way to test our love for Him is by asking, What am I partaking of? Have I been "chewing" on the sweet words of Scripture? And then accept this invitation, "Taste and see that the Lord is good" (34:8).

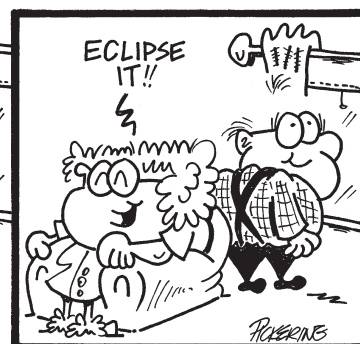
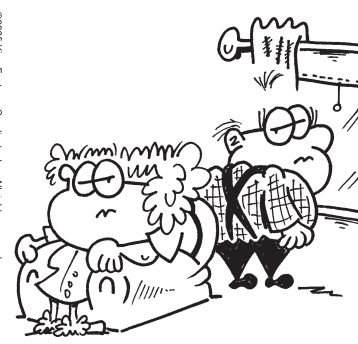
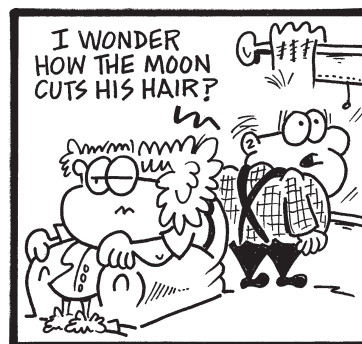

1/4 tsp. rubbed sage

1 boneless pork loin roast (4-5 lbs.)
2 Tbsp. olive or vegetable oil

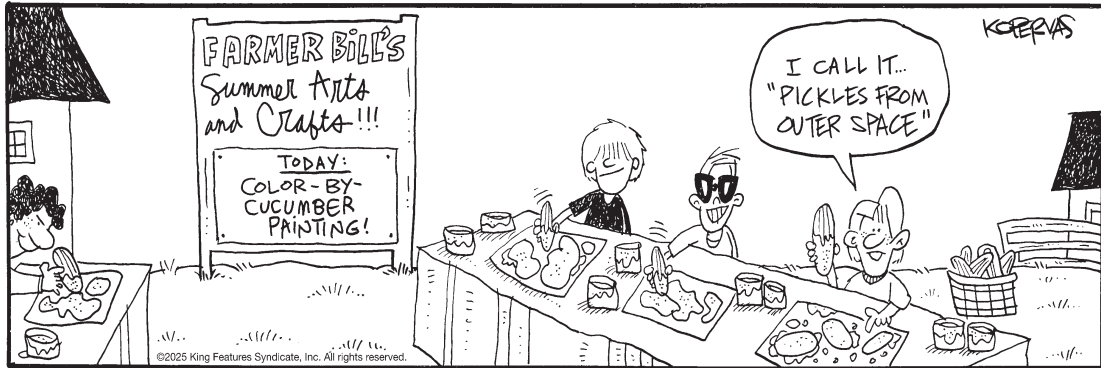

With their prevalence in nature and their benefits to humans, in the forms of pollinating plants and producing honey, it's no wonder they are often seen in decorative arts.

They play important roles in religion, mythology and folklore all over the world. They were a symbol of royalty in ancient Lower Egypt, a symbol for the ancient Greek oracle at Delphi and part of Napoleon's coat of arms.

They also appear as decorative motifs, invoking

their historical symbolism or simply adding realism to patterns of plants and flowers, on anything from inexpensive trinkets to valuable pieces by famous designers.

This small glass bowl with tiny bees flying among leafy branches sold for an impressive \$6,400 at Morphy Auctions. Its maker is a major

reason for its value: It is signed "Daum Nancy" for the famous art glass maker in Nancy, France, known for its decorated glassware featuring natural subjects.

Q: I have acquired from my aunt a box with items and fabrics she bought while stationed in occupied Japan. I would like to know where to take these items to determine if any are of value. Can you tell me who I should contact?

A: Formal appraisals are expensive, so you usually don't need one unless it is for legal purposes, like taxes or insurance, or if you are already certain you have something valuable like pieces made from precious metals. However, some auction houses hold free appraisal events as a form of promotion. There are less formal, less expensive ways to find out whether your items have value. You can visit antique shops in your area to talk to dealers and look at selling prices. Collectors' clubs can help find values. Look for collectors who specialize in Occupied Japan. Check price guides, you may be able to find subject-specific price guides online or at your library. You can look up prices for items like yours online. Try searching auction results or looking up sold listings online. Be sure you are looking at sold prices; asking prices are not always accurate.

TIP: Think about the signature on glass. Acid etched marks can be added. So can signatures. Be sure the mark seems appropriate.

Tree roots

A tree's root system keeps its trunk and canopy upright against the forces of wind and gravity. The strength of this system depends on soil type, soil moisture, tree species, root health and the depth and width of a tree's main structural roots. It has been found that in some trees, one root, or a suite of roots, supplies a specific branch or branches with nutrients, often on the same side of the tree as that root. Any damage to that root or roots manifest in damage to the corresponding branches.

Paws Corner

DEAR PAW'S CORNER: I have a 1-year-old mixed-breed puppy named "Star" who I'd love to take on Saturday hikes with me. I'm an avid hiker who can do up to 20 miles or more per day. Is this too much for a young dog like her to handle? — Gary in Boulder, Colorado

DEAR GARY: Your instincts are right-on — that kind of mileage is too much for a puppy. But, depending on the dog, you can build Star's stamina gradually, adding miles as she grows.

For a 1-year-old puppy, start with no more than a mile or two, and keep it light and fun. If Star whines at three-quarters of a mile, take a break for a few minutes and see if she'll go on. If she shows signs of tiredness, like lagging behind and not being curious about things around her, it's time to head back. Some pet parents will carry their puppy for the remaining miles, but that's up to you — I think that it's better to just gradually build the miles.

Notice that I also said "depending on the dog." Some dogs just aren't enthusiastic about hiking long miles. Others — especially small dogs, toy and pocket breeds — cannot walk very far without tiring. (Fortunately, they can be carried easily.) Don't lament if hiking ultimately isn't Star's thing; just build an outdoor schedule where she can share in the fun on some days with short hikes, and you can still get in lots of mileage while she remains at home or with a friend.

An adult dog can do 5 to 20 miles depending on their fitness and enthusiasm. But you'll need to adjust your lifestyle to gradually bring Star up to that kind of distance. ©2025 King Features Synd., Inc.
