



There's a man people hire as they're dying, paying him to show up at their funerals and reveal secrets they never shared while they were alive. The man has interrupted eulogies. He's asked stunned officiants to sit down when they started to

Having someone else confess for us (especially after we're dead) is a futile and risky way to deal with secrets. These stories, however, reveal a deep truth: we have a need to confess, to unburden ourselves. Confession cleanses us of those things that we've hidden and allowed to fester. "Confess your sins to each other," James says, "and pray for each other so that you may be healed" (5:16). Confession releases us from burdens that bind us, freeing us to commune with God—praying with a heart open to Him and to our faith community. Confession enacts healing.

James invites us to live an open life, confessing to God and those closest to us the pains and failings we're tempted to bury. We don't have to carry these burdens alone. Confession is a gift to us. God uses it to cleanse our heart and set us free. By Winn Collier



DEAR PAW'S CORNER: Thank you for discussing war dogs and their service with our armed forces. Can you highlight some non-military canine heroes, too? – Jim F., San Diego

DEAR JIM: Absolutely! Dogs have been performing heroic feats for as long as they've been our companions. But only a few have made it into the history books. Here are a few that some readers may not have heard of:

Balto and Togo: In January 1925, a diphtheria outbreak threatened the population of Nome, Alaska. To deliver lifesaving serum, teams of sled dogs relayed 500 miles across ice and snow in treacherous weather. Togo led his dog team across the longest, most dangerous part of the relay. Balto, a young and inexperienced husky, sprinted through fierce winds to reach the town in record time. Today, their journey is commemorated each year with the Iditarod sled race.

Buddy: In 1928, this German Shepherd became the first Seeing Eye dog in the United States. Born in Switzerland, she (yes, Buddy was a she) was trained by Dorothy Harrison Eustis, who ran a kennel that trained military and police dogs. Eustis matched Buddy to Frank Morris, a sight-impaired man from the U.S. Morris championed the use of Seeing Eye dogs, demonstrating Buddy's skill at leading him across busy Manhattan streets.

Riley: A Golden Retriever search-and-rescue (SAR) dog who became the face of SAR dogs in the wake of 9/11. At one point, Riley was sent alone in a basket over a 60-foot chasm to search the wreckage on the other side. He was one of many dogs who searched the World Trade Center rubble to recover those lost. Riley died in 2010, suffering various health problems, possibly from his time at Ground Zero. ©2025 King Features Synd. Inc.

An Inside Look at How PGC Staff Members Interact with our PA Black Bear Population

From 1950 to 1975, CBS hosted a game show called, "What's My Line?" The premise was a panel of celebrities had to guess the occupation of a guest

by asking questions about what they did for a living. Some were easy and others were very difficult to figure out. Let's see how you would do guessing an occupation. If I told you, part of their responsibilities are being an anesthetist, dentist, and a tattoo artist, would you have any idea what I'm talking about? How about if I add their job involves trapping, conflict resolution, and animal relocation? With this additional info, were you able to figure out I'm talking about some day-to-day responsibilities of a PA State Game Warden and their ongoing work with black bears.

On Friday, July 18 at the International Game Wardens Conference in Erie, I had the privilege of attending a twohour seminar conducted by PA State Game Warden Bill Brehun titled, "Black Bear Conflict Management." His district is in northeastern Westmoreland County, where he has served since 2016, and includes regular interactions with black bears across his rural district between Chestnut Ridge and the Laurel Highlands. With an audience from all over the U.S. and Canada, SGW Brehun started off with fascinating general info on PA black bears (ursus americanus). He placed PA's current estimated black bear population at 19,211 and shared that hunters typically harvest approx. >3,000 bears/year. With an average of 209,000 bear licenses sold each year, the success rate is typically 3% or less. He went on to share that in the Commonwealth, mature males typically have a home range of 20 sq. miles, while mature females occupy smaller home ranges of about 8 sq. miles. After hibernation, black bears prefer lower elevations, where they seek out fresh vegetation, such as skunk cabbage. However, in the Fall, they tend to gravitate to dense vegetation, frequenting mountain laurel and clear cut slashings. Prior to becoming dormant in their dens, black bears will feed up to 20-hours per day consuming up to 20,000 calories/day.

He went on to detail the average age of a PA black bear is 5 to 8-years old, while the oldest wild PA black bear was 34-years old. The PA State Record for a harvested black bear is 879 lbs. In PA, the vast majority of our black bears are actually black, with less than 3% being the cinnamon

(brown) phase and only 4 documented bears being white. Bears reach reproductive maturity at 3.5-years and their mating season is mid-June to mid-July. Females undergo delayed implantation and the eggs develop in Oct. – Nov. when they go into a den.

Cubs are born in Jan. or Feb. while the mother is in her den and they are initially the size of a pop-can. Feeding on a 30% fat milk concentration from their mother's six mammary glands, cubs' eyes open at 4-weeks old and they begin walking at 60-days. By Fall, they can weigh 60 to 100 lbs. I learned the average PA litter size is 3 cubs, while most sows I've seen have had two cubs. Bears may den in caves, crevices, hollow trees/logs, holes in the ground, above ground nests, or under a house.

SGW Brehun stressed that there are two different carrying capacities when it comes to PA black bears. There is the biological capacity of what the natural habitat can support and then there is the social capacity of what people will tolerate when it comes to human/bear interactions. With the proliferation of Ring doorbell cameras, it seems like bears are popping up everywhere, but he shared the bears have probably been there all along, but now people are capturing footage much more often. Our PA Game Wardens are given research quotas per district to capture, tag, and release so many bears as a health survey and population density estimate tool. On average, across PA, 700 bears ae captured and tagged each year. By capturing bears with culvert traps, SGWs become proficient in trapping and handling bears, so they are ready when they need to deal with a nuisance bear. People feeding bears directly or indirectly through unsecured trash cans or bird feeders, are the biggest causes of nuisance bears. Unfortunately, a fed bear, which is dependent upon human food sources, often becomes a dead bear after repeat offenses.

An amazing video detailed the process of trapping a bear and then sedating it, before taking its body temperature, extracting a milk tooth, attaching two ear tags, and tattooing a 5-digit ID# on its lip. Game wardens become an anesthetist, doctor, dentist, and tattoo artist with each bear. As SGW Brehun put it, "For each bear, it's like a bad night in Vegas, since they may wake up groggy, missing a tooth, and suddenly sporting two earrings and a new tattoo." The PGC has ongoing orphaned cub studies, urban bear studies, and survival studies with tracking collars. I received an invitation to assist with processing a bear sometime. I look forward to helping out and reporting back!

Enjoy a Taste of Italy With Tomato Pie

It tastes like summer when it's not. It looks like pizza, but it's not. So, what is it? Tomato pie! It's our new family favorite for when we long for something with a fresh and zesty Italian flavor. I serve it with a healthy green salad and crunchy French bread. Hungry yet?

Just pick up fresh tomatoes and garlic cloves, rub some fresh basil leaves between your fingers, and be transported to a different country as you prepare a tasty meal with your kids.

TOMATO PIE Ingredients:

- 19-inch refrigerated ready-made pie crust, or prepare an easy homemade crust (see recipe below)
- 1 1/3 cups shredded Italian-blend cheese or mozzarella
- 2-4 cloves fresh garlic, minced
- 2 tablespoons fine dry Italian-seasoned breadcrumbs
- 2 pounds fresh ripe tomatoes, cut into slices or wedges (about 6 cups)
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 cup chopped fresh basil

Here's the fun: Unfold pie crust. On a lightly floured surface, roll crust to a 12-inch circle. Place in a 9-inch pie plate or quiche dish. Flute edges with fingers. Bake according to product instructions until set and dry.

Remove from oven and sprinkle 1/3 cup cheese evenly over shell. Sprinkle garlic and 2 teaspoons of crumbs over cheese. Top with 1/3 of the tomato wedges or slices. Let

kids repeat sequence to form three layers topped with the remaining 1/3 cup of cheese. It will be full! Sprinkle with salt and bake in an ovenset to 375 F for 20-25 minutes, or until tomatoes are just starting to brown. Remove from oven and place on a wire rack.

Sprinkle with basil leaves. Let stand 10 minutes before serving.

ALTERNATE HOMEMADE CRUST Ingredients:

- 4 ounces cream cheese, softened
- 1/2 cup butter, softened
- 1 cup all-purpose flour - Pinch of salt

Place the cream cheese and butter in a large bowl. Add flour and salt. Work together with a pastry blender. Gather the soft dough into a ball with your hands and press into a 9-inch pie pan. This is a perfect job for your child to do. Simply set the ball in the middle of the pan, and press the dough out in all directions to extend it slightly over the rim.

Flute the edges with fingers. Prick holes with fork. Bake at 425 F for 8 minutes before topping it with the tomato pie ingredients.



Dividing perennials

Divide your fall-blooming perennials in the spring, and your spring- or summer-blooming perennials in the fall. Carefully dig up your parent plant and lift it out. Remove loose dirt around the roots, and clip off any dead material. Separate the plant into smaller divisions by gently pulling the sections apart, or cutting them with a sharp knife. Each division should have 3-5 vigorous shoots and a healthy supply of roots. Keep these divisions shaded and moist until they are replanted.


