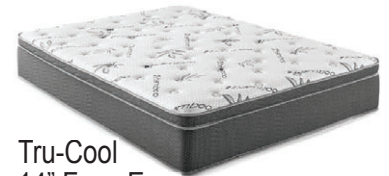

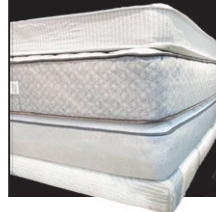

Q: I have a color print by Currier & Ives. How can I tell if it is an original?

A: Currier & Ives made their famous lithograph prints from 1857 to 1907. They have been reproduced many times since then. Check the size of your print. Currier & Ives prints were originally made in specific sizes. They could be very small (up to 7 x 9 inches), small (8 4/5 x 12 4/5 inches), medium (9 x 14 inches to 14 x 20 inches), and larger. Other sizes are usually later reproductions. Sometimes, original prints are trimmed to different sizes, which lowers their value. There are many books on Currier & Ives prints that can help you identify and value yours. Look for them at your library. A dealer who specializes in prints or books may be able to help you authenticate yours by its coloring, paper and printing method.

TIP: If using a glass shelf to display a paperweight collection, be sure it is strong enough. The ideal size is 18 inches long, 4 inches deep, 1/4 inch thick. Paperweights are heavy, and collectors tend to add "just one more." Glass will become more brittle and break with age. ©2026 King Features Synd., Inc.

Sharing a Few Additional Flintlock Tips to Counter Black Powder's Biggest Enemy

I'm sure you've heard the expression, "Keep Your Powder Dry!"

Many people probably think it's just another way of saying, "Be Prepared!" However, it has a much more significant scientific and historical basis. You see, true black powder that is employed as the propelling charge in the barrel of a flintlock rifle and as the priming charge in the flashpan is very hygroscopic. Hygroscopic is the scientific term for a substance's physical property of readily attracting and holding water molecules from the surrounding environment. The bottom line is black powder readily absorbs moisture from the air and becomes useless when damp or wet (it won't ignite properly), thus the very appropriate saying, "Keep Your Powder Dry!" from back in the day when flintlock ignition was the primary means for firing military and sporting rifles.

This is the reason armies back in the day of flintlock rifles went into "Winter Quarters" and there were very few military engagements from late Fall through Spring. An example of this during the American Revolution was the Continental Army under General George Washington going into "Winter Quarters" at Valley Forge on December 19, 1777 and not marching out until June 19, 1778. Unfortunately, flintlock hunters in Pennsylvania do not have the luxury of "Winter Quarters," since the current PA statewide late flintlock deer season runs from December 26, 2025 until January 19, 2026. Thus, those individuals who choose to hunt with these "primitive weapons" must constantly do battle against black powder's inherent hygroscopic properties, if they want their firearms to consistently ignite at the critical moment when they are taking aim at a deer. Allow me to share a few of the tips I've learned over the years to battle moisture.

1. After loading the propelling charge and patched roundball down the barrel of my flintlock rifle, I always seal the octagon barrel's muzzle with pieces of electrical tape. This keeps snow, rain, and moist air from entering the barrel. The massive hot gases created by the black powder's ignition when you pull the trigger blow the tape off the end of the barrel well before the patched roundball leaves the muzzle, thus it does not impede accuracy at all. (I also tape the barrels of my centerfire/rimfire rifles when hunting.)

2. Many hunters employ a lock cover to keep out snow and rain after they load the priming charge in their flashpans. Often called a "Cow's knee" or "Calf's knee,"

these leather lock covers were often originally made from skinned-out, tanned leather pieces of a cow or calf's leg and then treated with fat, wax, or oil to make them waterproof. I have also seen some modern lock covers made out of neoprene (the material wetsuits are made from). The trick is the lock cover needs to be easily removable when it comes time to take a shot. In addition to a lock cover, if you look at historical paintings, you see the "arm pit carry" of a flintlock rifle was prevalent to enable the storm flap of one's woolen or buckskin outer garment to keep one's powder dry. It still works today to move through the woods with the lock under your dry arm pit.

3. Condensation is black powder's nemesis and significant variations in temperature once your flintlock is loaded can potentially cause condensation. Keep in mind, a flintlock rifle is considered "unloaded" for transportation or storage purposes, if the priming charge is removed from the flashpan. Once I load my flintlock rifle and start hunting with it, it never comes back inside a heated building (home, camp, etc.). I empty the flashpan and the cold flintlock with loaded propelling charge is secured in an unheated, locked structure to avoid condensation contaminating the black powder. I have repeated this process for up to three weeks during the flintlock season and the rifle immediately fired with a fresh priming charge when called upon. It may be overkill, but I seal the vent hole with half of a round toothpick to keep air from reaching the propelling charge when it is between hunts. If you don't have an unheated location to safely store your flintlock, you're forced to discharge your rifle at the end of each day and then properly clean it.

4. In spite of your best efforts on damp days, the priming powder in your flashpan can turn to "soup" from its hygroscopic properties. That is why it is prudent to check it regularly and replace it, if it appears degraded. If I'm really concerned about dampness and I'm either hunting from a blind or in a tree stand, sometimes I won't even prime my flashpan until I hear or see a deer in the distance that may offer a shot. I just received the tip this Fall from a friend and fellow flintlock hunter, Larry Fedor, to apply a small amount of beeswax from a toilet bowl ring with a tiny popsicle stick around the outside edge of the closed frizzen after priming the pan to completely seal it. I'll let you know how that works out. Here's hoping you "Keep Your Powder Dry" and have a truly blessed 2026!

ICED CINNAMON STAR COOKIES

- 2 1/2 C. almond flour
 - 1 1/4 C. powdered sugar
 - 2 tsp. ground cinnamon
 - 1/4 tsp. salt
 - 2 large egg whites
 - 1 tsp. vanilla extract
- Icing:**
- 1 C. powdered sugar
 - 3 Tbsp. milk, more if needed
 - 1/2 tsp. vanilla extract

In a large bowl, whisk together almond flour, powdered sugar, cinnamon, and salt. Add egg whites and vanilla and mix until a soft dough forms. Wrap dough in plastic wrap and refrigerate for 30 minutes. Preheat oven to 300°F. Line a cookie sheet with parchment paper. On a surface dusted with powdered sugar, roll dough to 1/3" thickness. Cut out stars using a 3" star cookie cutter and transfer to prepared cookie sheet. Bake for 12-15 minutes until edges are lightly golden. Let cool on baking sheets for 5 minutes, then transfer to wire racks.

Icing:

Combine powdered sugar, milk, and vanilla with a fork. Use whisk to continue to stir the icing, adding more milk, in teaspoon increments if needed, to reach desired consistency. Once cookies are completely cooled, spoon icing on top of each star and spread with back of spoon or toothpick. You also can use a squeeze bottle or piping bag.

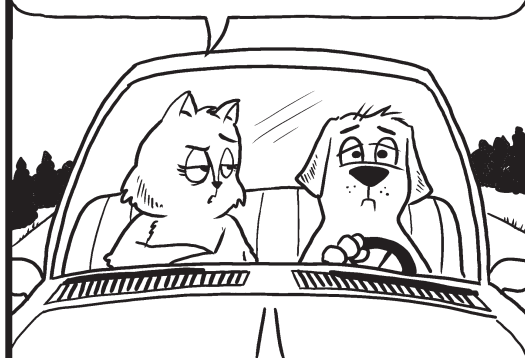

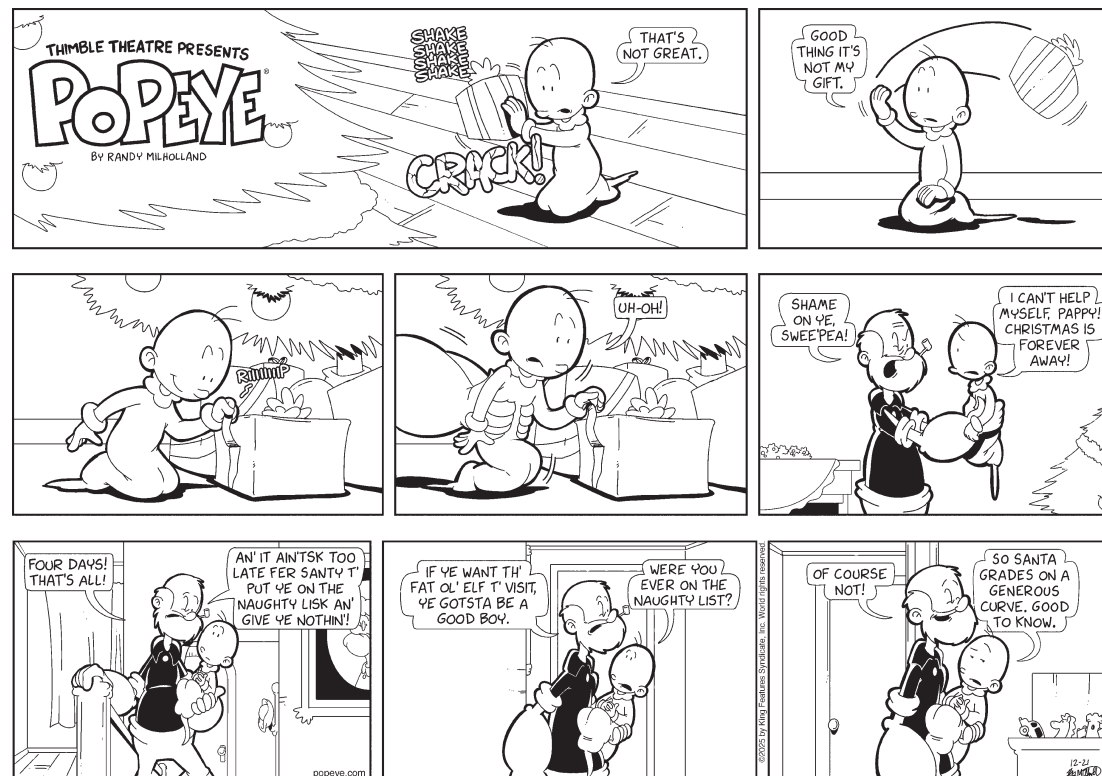

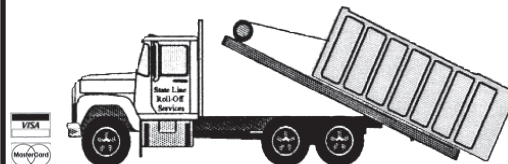

Our Daily Bread

The Hand of God

My own hand laid the foundations of the earth, and
my right hand spread out the heavens. Isaiah 48:13
READ Isaiah 48:12-19

In 1939, with the recent outbreak of war for Britain, King George VI sought in his Christmas Day radio broadcast to encourage citizens of the United Kingdom and the Commonwealth to put their trust in God. Quoting a poem that his mother found precious, he said: "Go out into the darkness, and put your hand into the Hand of God. / That shall be to you better than light, and safer than a known way." He didn't know what the new year would bring, but he trusted God to "guide and uphold" them in the anxious days ahead.

The image of God's hand appears in many places in the Bible, including in the book of Isaiah. Through this prophet, God called His people to trust that He as their Creator, "the first and . . . the last" (Isaiah 48:12), would remain involved with them. As He says, "My own hand laid the foundations of the earth, and my right hand spread out the heavens" (v. 13). They should put their trust in Him and not look to those less powerful. After all, He's their "Redeemer, the Holy One of Israel" (v. 17).

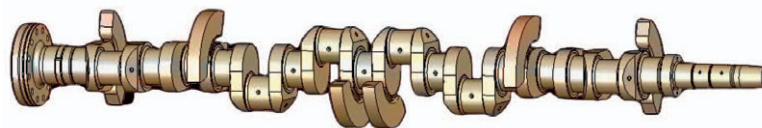

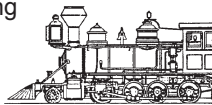

S'more Ideas to Start a New Year of Family Fun

The art of a roast is simple. Put a marshmallow on a stick and rotate it slowly over coals, just long enough to turn the white outside a toasty golden brown. But as all experienced marshmallow roasters know, if you leave it one second too long, the lusciousness instantly turns charcoal black. Patience is the key - a good lesson for rookie roasters of any age.

Warming up around a campfire, fire pit or grill to roast marshmallows for tasty s'mores is a great way to begin the practice of doing simple things that make big memories with family and friends in 2026. Plan the get-together soon with a challenge to create a new recipe. To get you started, here are some tasty twists and combinations inspired by recipes from Hershey:

- Peanut Butter S'mores: Spread a thin layer of peanut butter on half of a graham cracker and top with a piece from a milk-chocolate bar, a toasted marshmallow and half of a graham cracker. Vary by adding banana slices.
- Apricot Coconut S'mores: Spread a thick layer of apricot jam on half of a cinnamon graham cracker, and top with half of a milk-chocolate bar and a sprinkle of toasted coconut. Top with a piece from a milk-chocolate bar, a toasted marshmallow and half of another cinnamon graham cracker.
- Black Forest S'mores: Spread a thin layer of cherry pie filling on half of a chocolate graham cracker topped with a piece from a dark-chocolate bar.

Extra Idea: Make s'mores indoors in the microwave. On a small saucer, place a piece of a milk-chocolate bar on top of half of a graham cracker. Add one large marshmallow or several mini marshmallows.

Cook in your microwave on high for about 10-15 seconds, or until marshmallows puff and grow.

An adult should remove the plate from the microwave, top with the other half of the graham cracker and gently press down on the gooey marshmallow. Let cool a bit so that the snack isn't too hot.

Note: If you don't have a microwave, a toaster oven works fine, too. Cook the layered cracker, chocolate and marshmallow on the tray at 350 F until the marshmallow begins to brown. Remove and top with the other cracker half. Six s'mores will fit on most trays.

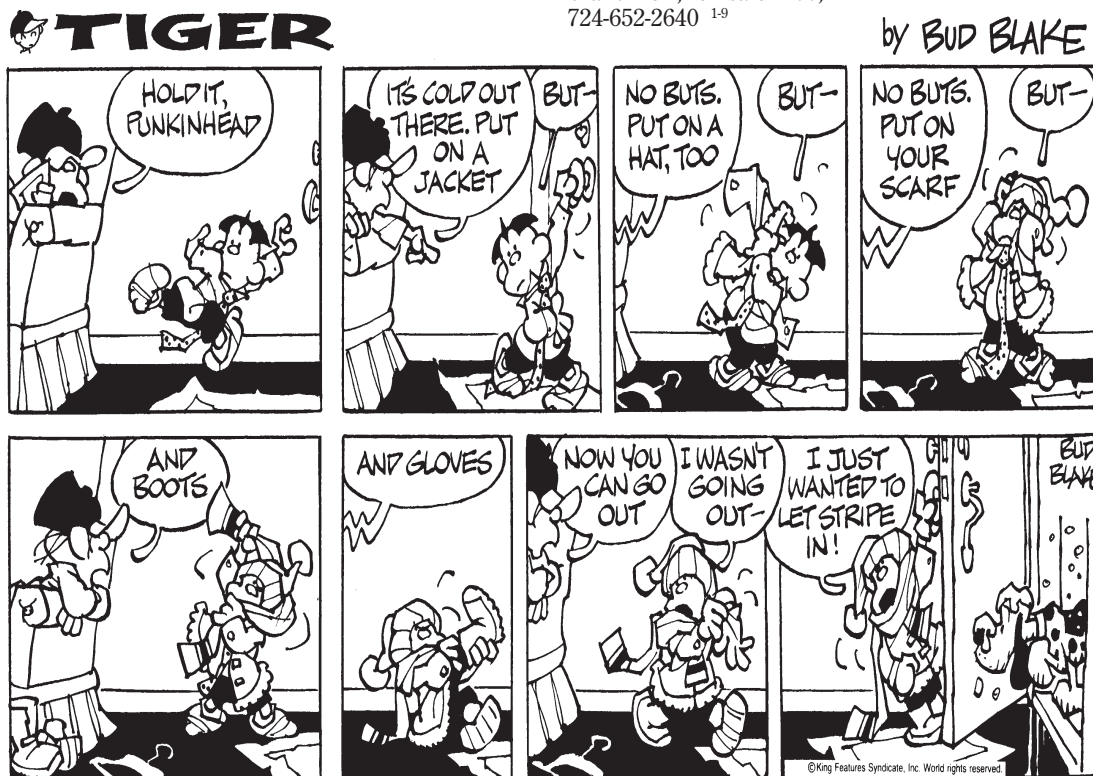
