Skimmer scams

Scammers are creative, you have to give them that. They come up with ways to steal from us that we've never thought about.

One new alleged scam involves a task we do frequently: pump gas into our car.

This scam has the thief inserting a tiny screw into the cradle where the nozzle rests on the pump. When you let go of the handle after pumping your gas and put it back in the cradle, it hasn't really released.

The machine thinks it's still in the middle of a transaction. The minute you drive away, a scammer can come along and continue pumping gas into his own vehicle, leaving you with the bill for it.

The good news? This scam is a hoax. While it's all over the internet, it's (apparently) not a real scam.

However, there are genuine scams involving sales anywhere you put your credit card into a machine. Beware of the following:

Credit card skimmers: Similar to what you'd look for at the ATM at your bank's drive-up, these little gadgets can read your card information or steal your PIN. Do an online search for "How to spot a credit card skimmer."

People who just want to help: If you've finished pumping gas and someone approaches you saying they will put the handle back, don't fall for it. This person won't put the handle all the way back into the pump (similar to the screw scam), making the machine think it's still an active transaction. When you drive off, they'll fill their own vehicle.

Self-checkout at the big box store: Before you start scanning your items, be sure there is nothing left on the screen from the previous customer. It's possible for them to scan an item and leave the transaction unfinished, until you come along and include their item in your own purchase.

Ongoing, Project OwlNet is a Great Example!**Have you ever heard of a mist net?
Do you know what they are used for?
Have you ever seen one "in action?"

A mist net is a nearly invisible nylon mesh tool that somewhat resembles a large volleyball net, which is highly specialized, and used by ornithologists, wildlife biologists, researchers, and other trained professionals to safely capture wild birds. Depending upon its length, it is either supported by vertical poles or fastened to trees, and when deployed, birds fly into the net and drop into loose horizontal pockets that ensnare them without causing injury. They are strictly used by trained professionals for avian research, tracking, and banding projects, since they are highly regulated and typically require federal bird banding permits. While ensnared in a mist net, birds may become stressed or targeted by predators, so researchers must constantly monitor their nets and they employ the gentle "body grasp" handling method.

When the Pennsylvania Outdoor Writers Association (POWA) visited the Ned Smith Center for Nature and Art in Millersburg, Pa on Fri., May 15; members were given the option of attending several different 1-hour breakout sessions after Executive Director Lara Maupin's opening assembly. I elected to attend a highly informative presentation on Project OwlNet, an ongoing research project studying the Northern Saw-Whet Owl. Many individuals have never even heard of a Northern Saw-Whet Owl, and the number of PA residents who have actually seen one are far fewer, due to their highly secretive, nocturnal habits. (I've only observed three, out in the wild, in my lifetime.) They are PA's smallest owl species, just 7 to 8 inches in length with an 18-inch wingspan, and weighing only 3 to 4 ounces. Good analogies are they're about the size of a pop can when sitting still and weigh about the same as a Blue Jay. There is a lot about Northern Saw-Whet Owls requiring further research, such as their breeding distribution, their migratory routes, and their wintering grounds. Project OwlNet is an ongoing effort to answer these vital questions.

In PA, the epicenter for Project OwlNet is the Ned Smith Center and their federal authority to conduct migratory bird banding stations falls under the permit of Project Coordinator, Ornithologist Scott Weisenthal. Our enthusiastic presenter on May 15 was Sandy Lockerman, one of three

Site Coordinators, who volunteer their extensive time and efforts monitoring their mist nets. Sandy explained the Northern Saw-Whet Owls (NSWOs) are migrating either through the trees or just above the trees, and are lured into their mist nets by an audio lure system (think an electronic game call), emitting a male NSWO aggression call. Peek migration is the last week of October, so Sandy and other citizen-scientist volunteers like her, are out in the cooler temperatures and darkness in Oct. and Nov. checking the mist nets every so many minutes to quickly process any captured owls. Each captured NSWO undergoes a series of measurements: bill length, body fat, keel fat, and eye color (using Benjamin Moore paint colors as a standardization tool). They determine each bird's sex using a mass/wing comparison chart, and in NSWOs (like many avian predator species), females are larger and males are smaller. They then age each individual owl by its molt pattern using a black light. After the short-term trauma of being captured and measured, the release process is simple, each individual owl is permitted to decide when it wants to fly away on its own.

Sandy shared some fascinating long-term findings with us. From 1997-2025, Project OwlNet totals are 10,407 NSWOs banded. They tend to capture a 20 to 1 female to male ratio in Oct. and Nov., since males stay on their breeding territories longer. Most catches are between 9 PM and Midnight, with bright moonlight bringing fewer catches. Young NSWOs migrate earlier and the adults come later. She mentioned over the years they have caught 272 owls that were previously banded at other sites and 607 owls they have banded in PA have been captured again at other sites. Highlights include the capture of a NSWO on Nov. 7, 2021 that had been banded only 10 days earlier some 1,887 miles away in Alberta, Canada (talk about an "Alberta Clipper" following the Jet Stream) and their oldest NSWO was captured on Nov. 14, 2022 after being banded in Ohio some 14 years, 5 months earlier. Sandy shared Project OwlNet has 75+ volunteers who are highly trained in net monitoring, photography, and data recording. NSWOs are cavity nesters who feed primarily on mice, insects, and frogs. Researchers have learned they primarily winter in the Carolinas and migrate back north in March and early April. The name Northern Saw-Whet Owl comes from their high-pitched whistled call, which sounds like a file sharpening a metal saw. This incredible tiny owl shares "Penns Woods" with us!

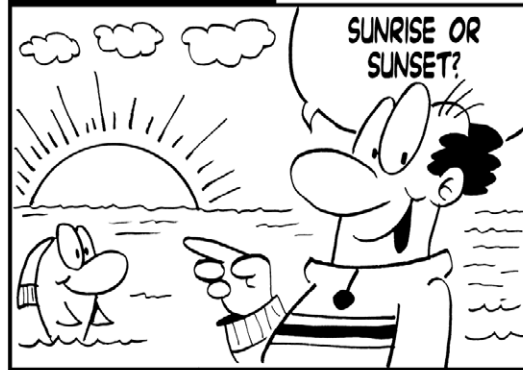

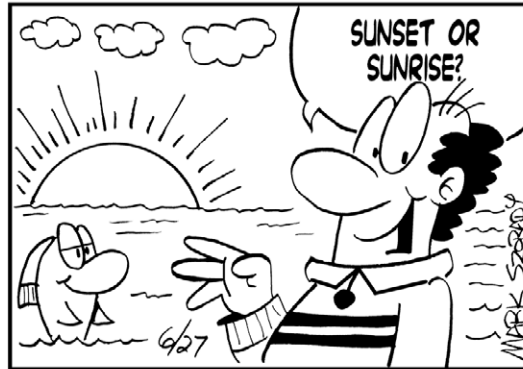

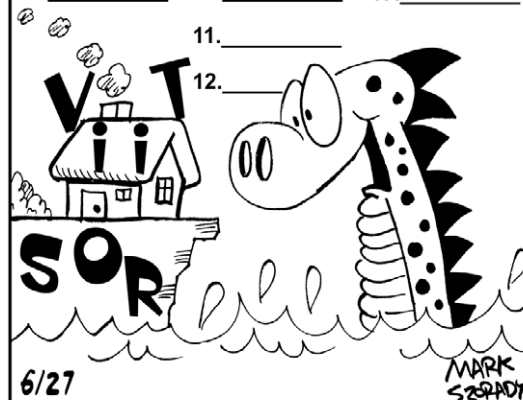

Make Delicious Slow-Cooker Yogurt

We're a yogurt-loving family! We wake up to it topped with crunchy granola and fruit, or it gets whirled with other



good stuff in the blender for energy-packed, to-go smoothies! It's an easy-to-pack car travel snack and the basic ingredient in homemade popsicles. Everyone around the dinner table enjoys rich, lemony-flavored yogurt over summer berries for dessert.

No wonder my ears perked up when a friend said she makes yogurt in her slow cooker! "Hmm," I thought. "Why add yogurt-making to my already busy schedule when I can just pick it up at the store?" Then, when curiosity took over, I did some research to test it out.

Much to my amazement, after a couple of easy steps in two timed intervals in the afternoon, I woke up the following morning to perfect, creamy, organic yogurt. Lots of it! Astounded, I ladled the more-than-we-could-use bounty into mason jars and shared the creamy deliciousness with my neighbors. Now they're hooked!

Lesson learned: The next time around, I halved my original recipe and got a yield of 7 cups. Give it

a try with your kids. It's cost-effective and nutrient-rich, and it also provides a memorable experience in kitchen science!

SLOW-COOKER YOGURT

- Makes 7 cups
- 8 cups whole milk (I use organic)
 - Food thermometer for testing milk temperature
 - 1/2 cup whole-milk, unflavored (plain) yogurt with live/active cultures for starter
 - Thick bath or beach towel
 - Storage containers with lids

Midafternoon, pour milk into your slow cooker and turn setting to low. Cover. Set a timer for 2 1/2 hours.

At 2 1/2 hours, use a kitchen thermometer to check that milk has reached 180-185 F.

Turn off, unplug, cover, and let the milk temp drop to around 115 F. Skim any milk film off the top of the milk with a spoon.

Remove 1 cup of the warmed milk and combine with room temperature yogurt in a small bowl. Gently stir.

Pour the mixture into the slow cooker and stir with a couple of strokes.

Cover and wrap the towel all around the slow cooker to help insulate. Culture 8-12 hours overnight.

In the morning, stir yogurt and ladle into storage containers. Refrigerate at least 4 hours before eating. Save 1/2 cup to use as a starter for your next batch.

Cook's Note: For variety, make Greek-style yogurt. Spoon 2 cups of the slow-cooker yogurt into a strainer lined with cheesecloth or coffee filters. Let the liquid (whey) drip through for about 30 minutes. Makes 1 1/4 cups of yummy, thick yogurt. Delicious!

Q: I purchased this larger size hourglass (about 15-minute timer) from the gift shop of the Pirates of the Caribbean ride at Magic Kingdom at Disney World in April 1976. Unfortunately, it has no marking or labels anywhere. It has no damage whatsoever. Do you know of any collectors who might be interested in this piece? Other than a Disney collector, I believe it would have limited interest.

A: You are right that a Disney collector would be the best buyer for your hourglass. Fortunately, there are plenty of Disney collectors out there! While Disney memorabilia, including theme park souvenirs, can be found at many auctions, particularly toy auctions, and antique stores, there are some auction houses that specialize in it. You may want to contact an auction house like Van Eaton Galleries (vegalleries.com) or Hake's Auctions (hakes.com), both of which hold auctions dedicated to Disney memorabilia. Your hourglass could be worth hundreds of dollars to the right buyer. A souvenir hourglass from the Haunted Mansion ride sold for \$130 at an auction in 2024. A Pirates of the Caribbean souvenir mug from about 1990 sold for \$380 at another auction.

••• Getting to Know the Declaration of Independence •••

The Declaration of Independence is a formal document that served as the signatory colonies' statement that they were now "free and independent States." It is a vital document in American history.

On July 1, 1776, delegates from the original 13 colonies, making up the Second Continental Congress, met in Philadelphia to vote on Richard Henry Lee's motion for independence. After some deliberation, ultimately 12 of the 13 delegates voted in favor. In recognition of those 12 delegates, here are 11 facts regarding the Declaration of Independence.

1. The drafted document was officially adopted on July 4, 1776, two days after freedom from Britain was approved. However, most delegates signed the document on August 2, 1776, while others signed on a later date. John Dickinson and Robert R. Livingston never signed the Declaration of Independence.

2. John Dunlap was the official printer of Congress at the time. He worked all night and into the morning of July 5 to produce the large, single-sided sheet, known as a broadside. About 200 copies of Dunlap's broadside were made.

3. The University of Virginia owns two copies of a rare early printing of the Declaration. It is on display in the Albert and Shirley Small Special Collections Library. It is believed the copy once belonged to George Washington.

4. Benjamin Franklin, George Read, Roger Sherman, Robert Morris, George Clymer, and James Wilson signed both the Declaration of Independence and the U.S. Constitution.

5. The Declaration of Independence and the Constitution were hidden at Fort Knox during World War II, two weeks after Pearl Harbor was attacked.

6. Despite what the movie "National Treasure" will have one believe, the message on the back of the document is visible and reads "Original Declaration of Independence dated 4th July 1776."

7. Richard Stockton, a lawyer from New Jersey, was a signer of the Declaration who later recanted his support of the American revolution. He subsequently swore his allegiance to King George III after being captured by the British.

8. In 1989, an original Dunlap Broadside was found hidden behind a picture a Philadelphia man bought at a flea market for \$4. It later sold for \$8.1 million. Ultimately, 26 copies of the original prints have been found.

9. The United States celebrates Independence Day on July 4th, even though independence was accepted on July 2nd.

10. The one-year anniversary of Independence Day and the celebration of the adoption of the Declaration of Independence slipped the minds of Congress in 1777. When they remembered it was July 3rd, they planned a last-minute celebration on July 4th, and each year thereafter.

11. John Trumbull's painting "Declaration of Independence," which was made into a lithograph replica by Ralph Trembly, hangs in the Rotunda of the U.S. Capitol. It is a fictional depiction of the five-man drafting committee presenting their draft to Congress, and not the signing. The painting shows 42 of the 56 signees, since Trumbull couldn't get likenesses of all involved. The men featured in the painting were never all in the room at the same time during the Declaration's debate and signing.

The Declaration of Independence is a key document in American history, and its words are celebrated each Independence Day.
